Pvt. Bernard Barthman, member of the Corps of Engineers, was wounded in action a second time in Luxembourg Feb. 18. His parents, Mr. and Mrs. George Poyer, 11 Myrtle Hill Pl., have learned. Private Barthman entered service in May, 1943, and has been overseas since September, 1944. He was previously wounded in France last summer. Holder of the Bronze Star Medal, he attended Aquinas Institute.

Pvt. James J. Sullivan, 18, son of Mr. and Mrs. John J. Sullivan, 73 Woodbury Ave., was wounded in the hand Feb. 24 in action in France, according to word reaching the parents. A graduate of Aquinas Institute, Private Sullivan studied at Holy Cross College, Worcester, Mass., before going into service in February, 1944. Sent overseas in December, 1944, he has been awarded the Expert and Combat Infantryman's Badge and the Purple Heart.

Sgt. Richard M. James, 23, son of Mrs. Blanche St. James, 137 Arnett Blvd., was slightly wounded in action Jan. 20 in Belgium. His wife, Dorothy St. James, 100 Ravenwood Ave., has learned. A paratrooper, Sergeant St. James enlisted in April, 1943, and went overseas in August, 1944. He is the father of a two-year-old daughter, Caroline Ann, and he has two brothers in service, S/Sgt. Edgar St. James, with the AAC in

San Antonio, Tex., and Pvt. Leo and Mr. James in Paris.

Pvt. Thomas Williams, 19, was wounded in action with the Infantry Mar. 1 in Germany. His parents, Mr. and Mrs. James Williams, 21 Gordon Pl., have learned. A member of St. Bridget's parish, Private Williams entered service in April, 1944, and went overseas last December. His brother, Corporal Michael J. Williams, 22, veteran of the Italian campaign, has been returned to this country for rest and re-enlistment.

Pvt. Francis A. Smith, 19, participant of St. John the Evangelist Church, was slightly wounded in action Mar. 1 in Germany. His mother, Mrs. Blanche Smith, 31 Marion St., has been informed. Giebel, 312 Clifford Ave., has returned to his base in Italy after being reported missing over Yugoslavia Feb. 18, his parents have learned.
