Corning Mr. and Mrs. William J. Garvey, 112 W. Third St., have been informed that their son, Pvt. John F. Garvey, has been awarded the Purple Heart for wounds received in action in Germany early in March. A recent letter from the young soldier, however, reports that he has returned to action. Pvt. Garvey, who has been overseas since early this year, was a student at Corning Free Academy when he entered the service in August, 1941.

Lt. Florence Healy, stationed in England with the Army Nurses Corps, has been promoted from second to first lieutenant according to word received by her parents, Mr. and Mrs. J. F. Healy, 204 Chestnut St.

A graduate of St. Mary's Parochial School and Corning Free Academy, Lt. Healy received her nurse's training at St. Joseph's Hospital, Elmira. She enlisted in August, 1941, and has been overseas since August, 1942.
