American Bishops Ask World Bill of Rights; Score Yalta Rulings on Poland, Vote Setup

Washington - (RNS) - St. Bernard Alumaus Adoption by the San Francisco Conference of an International Bill of Rights guaranteeing rivil and religious liberties to the implies of all countries was urged in a statement issued here by the Archbishops and Bishops of the Administrative Board of the National Catholic Welfare Conl'orrence.

Signed by seven archbishops and three bishops, the statement

"In all history, and particularly in modern history, dangers to world peace have come from the unjust treatment of minorities. the denial of civil and religious librities and other infringements on the inborn rights of men. To remove these dangers, the nations should adopt an International Bill of Rights in which men and groups everywhere would be guaranteed the full en-Joyment of their human rights."

The hierarchy urged that acreptance of this Bill of Rights la notifica a condition of active participation in the world ecurity organization.

Major points in the hishops statement included:
