

**Bishops' 2 Statements Appear in Leaflet Form**

Washington (N.Y.) — The recent statement issued by the Archbishops and bishops of the Administrative Board of the National Catholic Welfare Conference entitled "Organizing World Peace," and the statement issued by the Abolitionists and Bishops of the United States at their annual meeting here last November, entitled "International Order," have been printed in leaflet form by the National Catholic Welfare Conference and are now available. It has been translated here.

Washington (N.Y.) — A letter received by the Rev. Peter F. Quinn, S.M., of the Marist Seminary here, from a Marist missionary nun at the leper hospital in Spanish Town, Jamaica, H.W.I., reveals the fact that, last Christmas, the late President and Mrs. Roosevelt sent a personal greeting card to each of the nuns under whose care the leprosarium is conducted.
