Books on Trial

Wm. L. White's Report on the Russians, \$2.50, is being criticized as politically independent. He writes with greater frankness than is considered advisable by those who have nothing but praise for the Soviets.

Mr. White, whose former books — *They Were Expectable* and *Queen's Life* — are because best sellers, is a keen reporter and his "report" is the result of his trip through Russia with the president of the U. S. Chamber of Commerce.

It seems evident that, although Mr. White is not a Red-baiter, he is quite in agreement with the belief that if the Soviets are for the common man, the common man had better be pretty certain that he is for the Soviets. He thinks that much of what Russia has accomplished has been through our supplies and assistance — although none of the ordinary Russians have any idea that such is the case. The ordinary Russian, in fact, has practically no opinion at all such as we know it, and nothing worth while has been done under the Communist system that we had not done better long ago. Despite the criticism, — or maybe, because of it — this book should have wide circulation.

An unusual novel in literature, a Brazilian classic written in 1872 and said to be the second most widely translated Portuguese book. It is essentially a novel of protest against the traditional tyranny of men over women.

Generations of Brazilians have wept over the gentle Inocencia, daughter of a decadent Minister who had promised her in marriage without her knowledge or consent to a swindling suitor.

Inocencia had fallen in love with a doctor who had saved her life. But her father's code was inflexible. True breaks, but the word of a Minister never.

The author, Viscount Tamy, is highly renowned in Brazilian literature and as a member of the National Parliament promoted important reforms in civil marriage and the abolition of slavery. His book is a welcome change from our usual American best-sellers — and satisfactory for all. \$2.50.

Too Small a World, \$2.50, is the story of Mother Franchese

A Military Star of the Sacred Heart, this courageous man who established 67 schools here in Europe, Central and South America, was killed in 1938. Therefore Maynard's biography is written in a pleasant, poetic conversational style that should attract many readers who had not previously known of this heroic woman and her marvelous activities.

Hilaire Belloc is known primarily for his prose — and for a noisy controversialism, but his unique humor and sardonic wit make his poetry — and in his poetry. Experts have called him England's greatest living poet. His collected poems have now been published under the title *Belloc's and Verse*, \$2.50. Q.—A married woman wishes to be advised if married women may join the WAC?

A.—Yes, married women are eligible for enlistment in the WAC.

Q.—A man recently discharged from the Army inquires if it is advisable for him to obtain his National Service Life Insurance and what is when he should make the premium payments?

A.—We would advise you to continue your service insurance, as it is the lowest rate premium you can obtain. You make your check or money order payable to the Treasurer of the United States and mail same to Collection Subdivision, Veterans Administration, Washington, D. C., giving your full name, service serial number, your insurance certificate number and your present address.

Q.—A reader asks what is the Government, Department of Labor Act of 1941?

A.—It is the law passed by Congress to provide family allowances for the dependents of killed men of the Army, Navy, Marine and Coast Guard. The members of the women's service may also authorize a family allowance.

Q.—A former Navy man wishes to know how to secure a copy of his service record?

A.—Direct your request to Bureau of Naval Personnel, Navy Department, Washington, D. C. You should state date and place of your induction, date and place of your discharge, date and place of your last assignment, the number, your full name and rank at the time of discharge.

Q.—A mother asks if it is true that a serviceman must be killed in action to enter for his beneficiary to collect his government insurance?

A.—National Service Life Insurance is payable on account of death to the beneficiary or to the estate of the insured. The beneficiary must be named in the policy and must survive the insured.
