

Stirring 'American Day' Rally Planned

Mayor Samuel B. Dicker has announced that the "I Am An American Day" committees have developed an entertaining, patriotic, hour-and-a-half-long program to be presented at the Eastman Theater, Sunday evening, May 29, at 8 p. m. The public is invited to attend to honor those newly naturalized citizens and native-born citi-

zens who have reached their majority in 1945. Presentation of the massed colors of all the veteran organizations of the city at the opening of the program is one of the most colorful rites of the year. The pupils of the public schools also will give a tableau of the raising of the flag by the Marines on Iwo Jima. Rehearsals indicate that the audience will be thrilled

by the presentation of Joe Fontana's famous picture which has now been adapted as the official Seventh War Loan poster. The School Participation Committee, co-chaired by Rev. Dr. Charles J. Mahoney and Superintendent James M. Splaingard, is preparing a patriotic musical program of selections by The Aquinas Institute Band and

numbers by the Inter High Chorus of the Public Schools. The Civic Participation Committee, co-chaired by Anthony Capone and John W. Cooper, invite the support of all labor, patriotic, and civic organizations of the city. A colorful and representative body of honored guests will consist of the uniformed units of the American Red Cross veteran, and nationality groups in native costume.

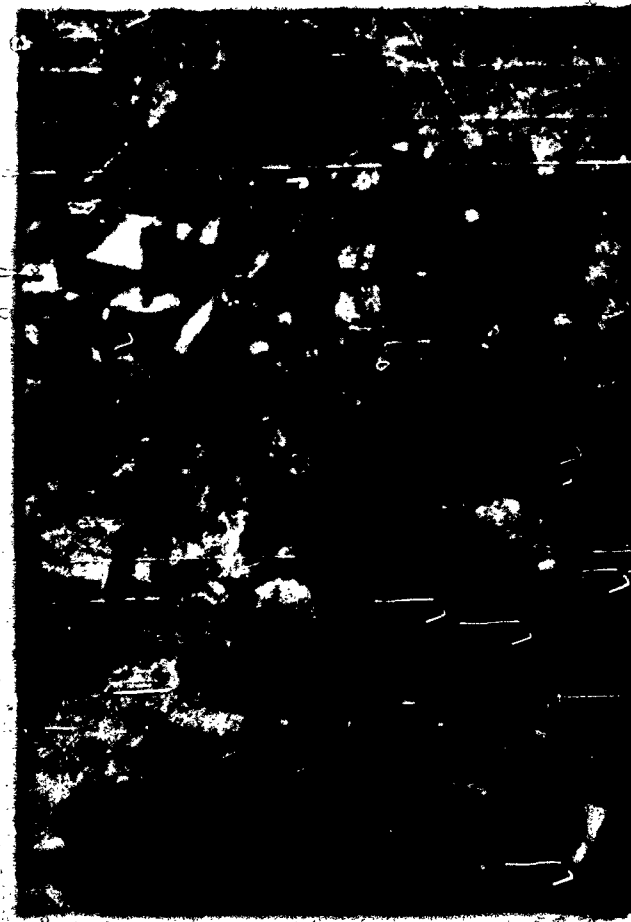
