Holy Cross Priest To Sing First Mass

The Rev. Raymond E. Finan, C.S.C., whose home is at 20 Arch Street, Rochester, will be ordained priest in Sacred Heart Church at the University of Notre Dame on June 10, by the Most Rev. Amleto Giovanni Cicognani, Apostolic Delegate to the United States.

He received his education at Corpus Christi Grade School, St. Andrew's Seminary, St. Bernard's Seminary, and Moreau Seminary at the University of Notre Dame. During the course of his studies for the priesthood, Father Finan began his apostolic work by teaching catechism at the National Training School for Boys in Washington, D. C.

Father Finan will celebrate his first Solemn High Mass at Corpus Christi Church on June 17. The Rt. Rev. Msgr. William M. Hart, V.G., pastor of Corpus Christi Church will be Assistant Priest. Rev. Francis M. Feeney, a cousin of Father Finan, will be Deacon, and Rev. John J. O'Mears, C.S.B., also a cousin, a teacher at Aquinas Institute, Sub Deacon. Sermon will be preached by Rev. James W. Conneron, C.S.C., Registrar of the University of Notre Dame.

Parents Lauded at St. Agnes High Dinner

Over 200 parents and friends of the St. Agnes High School graduating class attended the Graduation Banquet held Saturday evening, June 2 in the Powers Hotel Ball Room.

Addressing the gathering, His Excellency, Bishop Kearney pointed to the Catholic school as the only real adequate answer to the problem of delinquency among present day youth.
