The supreme sacrifice has been made by Three Catholic servicemen of the Rochester area, two are reported missing in action and four were wounded in battle, according to the week's casualty report. Families of six area fighting men have received word of their liberation.

Requiem Mass for 1st Lieut. George J. Klem, 26, was offered in Corpus Christi Church Thursday (May 31, 1945).



Lieut. Klem, son of Mr. and Mrs. Bernard A. Klem, 26 Baldwin St., died as a result of an accidental fall in France May 17. In service since Apr. 29, 1941, he saw service in Ireland and England as a member of the Medical Administration Corps and in a U. S. Hospital in France. He was a member of the Knights of Columbus and E. of C. Choral Society.

Surviving besides his parents are his wife, Mrs. Rita Davison Klem of Nanticoke, Pa., who served in France with the Army Nurse Corps; two brothers, Norbert B. Klem, 210 Elmdorf Ave., and Carl A. Klem of the Baldwin Street address; a sister, Mrs. Harry Van Scater, 1 Doran Street.

Memorial Mass for EM 2/o Vito M. Petrilli, 21, who was killed aboard an aircraft carrier in the Pacific, was celebrated Tuesday (June 5, 1945) in St. Lacey's Church.

Petrilli went into service in November, 1942 and overseas in February, 1944. Also surviving are a brother John, serving with the Seabees in the Marianas and a grandmother, Mrs. John Petrilli, 72 Jefferson Ter.

Funeral services for Ensign John F. Darcy, 25, son of Mr. and Mrs. George Darcy, 633 Jefferson Ave., were conducted Friday morning (June 2, 1945) in immaculate Conception Church. Burial was in Holy Sepulchre Cemetery.



Ensign Darcy, who had been stationed in Norfolk, Va., was killed Sunday (May 27, 1945) in attempting a forced landing near DuBois, Pa., the official notification revealed.

The young Navy officer, first Rochester youth to be accepted for enrollment with the Naval Cadet Selection Board, was signed on in October, 1942 and joined the Genesee, a local group of cadets.

Lieutenant Darcy leaves, besides his parents, two brothers, Pfc. Milton F. Darcy, overseas and Lt. (j. g.) George R. Darcy, USNR, in California.

Sgt. Moses Gianni, 29, a 2-1/2 artilleryman was wounded in action in Germany Apr. 16 and is now in a hospital in France, according to word received by his wife, Mrs. Anne D. Gianni.


Son of Rosario Gianni, 437 Smith St., Sergeant Gianni went into service in April, 1944 and overseas last December. He attended Aquinas Institute.

A sister and two brothers are in service: S1/c Ross A. Gianni, Norfolk, Va.; Lieut. Joseph A. Gianni, Luzon, and Pfc. Stephen A. Gianni, Rhoads General Hospital, Utica.

Sgt. George F. Gleason, 20-year-old engineer-gunner, has been missing in action since his 10th mission made over the Kuriles in a Liberator bomber, his parents, Mr. and Mrs. James

A. Gleason, Phelps Road, Honey Falls have been notified. A graduate of Aquinas Institute, Sergeant Gleason entered service in August, 1943 and went

overseas last January. He has a brother, Lt. Donald M. Gleason, serving in England with an infantry unit.
