**Widows of Heroes Get Honor Medals**

Troy — (NC) — The widows of two Catholic heroes killed in action on Saipan were presented here with the Congressional Medal of Honor, awarded posthumously last March to their husbands, Lt. Col. William J. O'Brien and Sgt. Thomas A. Baker, both of the 105th Infantry, 27th Division, New York National Guard.

Undersecretary of War Robert F. Patterson, who made the presentation, assured Mrs. Margaret O'Brien and Mrs. Constance Baker that "the memory of these two brave soldiers of the Army will never fade."
