CATHOLIC WAR VETERANS

(Address all communications to Catholic War Veterans, Inc., Public Relations Bureau, 1103 Empire State Bldg., New York 1, N.Y.)

**ATTENTION:** World War I Veterans, Adjusted Service Bonds which mature on January 15, 1945, may be presented for payment now at the Post Office Federal Reserve Bank or branch, or directly to the U. S. Treasury, Washington, D. C. These Adjusted Service Bonds were commonly called Bonus Bonds.

**Q.**—A wife asks who will receive the money in her husband's soldier's deposit account, if he should be killed, his mother or herself?

**A.**—This deposit account is considered part of a soldier's estate. If he dies it would go to the person he has named as his beneficiary.

**Q.**—Is a widow of a serviceman who is receiving \$35 per month from her husband's government insurance entitled to a pension for herself and her child? Her husband was killed in action.

**A.**—A widow and child of a man who dies in the present war are entitled to a monthly pension of \$35, regardless of any other income. National Service Life Insurance payments are not considered as income by the government. The widow's pension is \$35 a month, and would continue until her death or remarriage. The \$35 monthly allowance for the child would continue until the child reaches 18 or 21 if the child is attending school unless the child marries.

**Q.**—My son was killed in action in the Pacific and named me as his principal beneficiary and he named my youngest son as his contingent beneficiary. At my death would the unpaid balance be part of my estate or would it be paid to my younger son?

**A.**—When a contingent beneficiary is named, the payments still due at the time of your death would go to the youngest son.

**Q.**—Can you advise me how many years training a disabled veteran may get under the vocational training program? What allowance also?

**A.**—The length of vocational

During authorized training you may receive an allowance of \$35 a month if you are a single veteran, and married veterans receive \$36.50 a month. Extra allowances of \$3.75 a month for each child and \$1.50 for each dependent parent.

**Q.**—Where can I get all the

particulars regarding veterans' insurance?

**A.**—We have obtained to you the official Veterans Administration booklet on National Service Life Insurance. Readers wishing to receive a copy at no charge may do so simply addressing a post card and asking for the booklet and print name and address plainly. Booklets on Educational Benefits of the G. I. Bill are also available for the asking.
