Churchill Tutor Dies in Canada

Winnipeg (NC) — The Rt. Rev. Msgr. Thomas W. Morton, son of a former Anglican minister and one-time tutor of Prime Minister Winston Churchill of Great Britain, has died here at the age of 83.

Monsignor Morton came to Canada from England in 1919 and was rector of St. Mary's Cathedral here from 1920 until 1934. His father was converted to the Catholic Faith by the late Cardinal Newman in 1853 in Birmingham.
