

Franciscan Priest Bid Farewell by Parishioners

Auburn - Rev. On Sunday afternoon he will be tendered a reception at the Jefferson Hotel from 3:30 to 5:30 p. m. when he will renew old friendships and greet new friends.

Son of Mr. and Mrs. Frank Schimizzi, Clarence St., he was born June 11, 1918. He attended Watkins Glen Grammar and High School and was graduated from the high school in June 1937.

In June 1939 he entered the Pious Society of Missions and was sent to Italy where he studied at the Rocco Priora in Rome. At the outbreak of war he returned to America in the summer of 1942. He entered St. Mary's Seminary in Baltimore to continue his studies for the priesthood under the Sulpician Fathers.

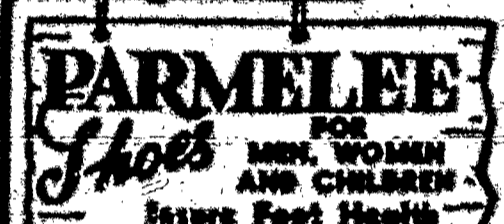

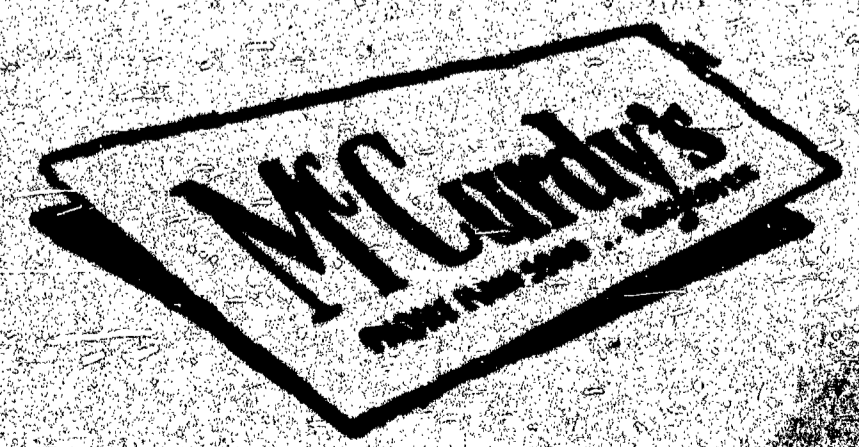
