'GLACIER PRIEST' PRESENTS STATUE TO POPE; TALKS TO GIs

Vatican City—(NC)—His Holiness Pope Pius XII received a carved ivory miniature of the statue of Christ the King, a symbol of peace, which dominates King Island between Asia and North America, when he received the Rev. Bernard R. Hubbard, S.J., the American "Glacier Priest." In audience, the miniature, presented by Father Hubbard, was a gift of Alaskan Eskimos to the Holy Father.

Father Hubbard is in Europe photographing Jesuit houses destroyed in the war. He is also giving lectures to American soldiers, with technicolor illustrations, on the post-war possibilities of Alaska. His talks, he reports, draw thousands of interested soldiers.

"These men seem more responsive and appreciative than any other audience I have ever addressed," Father Hubbard said.

Recalling a visit he paid to Europe at the close of the last World War, and noting conditions now, Father Hubbard said "Europe has so little in material resources that when war flattens it it is really down. As in every catastrophe, the innocent suffer with the guilty. After World War One there were a number of riots in many countries and much political unrest. Europe must decide for itself whether it wants destruction or reconstruction. Atheistic communism means destruction. A return to basic honesty, justice, mercy and particularly charity, as well as to other Christian virtues, may bring about happy reconstruction. I can only see hope for Europe in the practical application of the Four Freedoms. Freedom of religion is not the least of these."

Army Priest, Vet of 22 Assault Landings, Cited

Honolulu — (NC) — Lieut. Col. Leonard A. LeClair, priest of the Diocese of Portland, Maine, and head chaplain of the 96th Division on Okinawa, has been decorated with the Bronze Star for bravery during the Leyte campaign.

When Father Le Clair, who is a veteran of 22 assault landings in the Pacific, received his decoration, one of the first to congratulate him was Col. Philip J. Newman, priest of the Diocese of Springfield in Illinois, who holds the same decoration.

Assigned to U. S. Ship Named for His Brother

Cleveland — (NC) — Serving on the ship named for his brother is a dream come true for Radio Technician Lawrence Halloran, graduate of Cathedral Latin School here. The U. S. S. Halloran is named for his brother, Ensign William Halloran, who was killed in the attack on Pearl Harbor and was the first man of this city to die in World War II. Another brother, Pharmacist Marc John is station in the Philippines.
