**Three Corning Servicemen  
Return Home from Overseas**

Corning — Two soldiers and one sailor are among those on leave at their homes in Corning and vicinity after duty overseas. They are Pfc. John Markert, Pfc. Carmes Russo and Robert Sullivan, aviation ordnanceman second class.

Pfc. Markert, the son of Mr. and Mrs. J. Harold Markert, of 417 W. High St., Painted Post, who has been serving in Italy for the past several months, will report to Fort Dix, N. J., at the end of his 30 day furlough. Pfc. Russo, who is spending his leave with his parents, Mr. and Mrs. Aniello Russo, 304 W. First St., is a veteran of the European Theater of Operations. He is the

holder of the Combat Infantryman's Badge and the ETO ribbon with five battle stars. Two of his brothers are also in the service. They are Corp. Louis Russo, in the Pacific area, and Pfc. Anthony Russo, in Germany. Aviation Ordnanceman 2/c Sullivan, son of Mr. and Mrs. Charles R. Sullivan, of 428 Delaware Ave., has been in the Pacific area for the past 20 months. He will report at Jacksonville, Fla. at the expiration of his leave.

Corning — A release from a 27th Air Transport Group Base in Villacoublay, France, announced recently that Master Sergeant Paul D. Hickey, son of Mr. and Mrs. E. L. Hickey, of 266 Cutler Ave., this city, is in charge of proper occupational placement of hundreds of 27th Air Transport Group sky and ground soldiers.

According to the dispatch C-47 Skytrains of Sergeant Hickey's 302d Transport Wing Unit fly over a thousand high priority passengers and more than 30,000 pounds of critical cargo daily from Villacoublay, Paris Air Terminal to key occupational points in Europe and the United Kingdom.

Since entering the service in January, 1942, Sgt. Hickey has earned three battle stars for taking part in the campaigns of Northern France, Rhineland and Central Europe.

**Sister's Death Recalls  
Attempt to Fly Atlantic**

London — (NC) — One of the early tragic attempts to fly the Atlantic was recalled this week by the death of Lady Mary Saville, daughter of the late Earl of Mexborough.

In an airplane named "St. Raphael," her sister, Princess Lowenstein-Wertheim set out with two companions at the end of August 1937 to attempt the first flight from England to North America. Nothing more was heard of them.
