Chaplain McMillea Locates Graves of 3 Martyr Priests

Searching for the graves of three murdered Dutch priests was the grim task of Navy Chaplain Gervase McMillea, O.F.M., following his participation in the invasion of a Japanese-held Dutch island shortly before the end of the war in the Pacific.

Father McMillea, whose mother Mrs. Helen C. McMillea lives at 336 South Goodman St., Rochester, conducted many missions and retreats in the Diocese of Rochester prior to his becoming a chaplain.

Concerning his search on the Pacific island for the bodies of the Dutch priests he writes:

"The three priests were captured when the Japanese came ashore three and a half years ago. They were worked as coolies for about two months. Then they were paraded fettered before the natives, blindfolded and told to march into the sea.

"When the water was up to their shoulders they were machine-gunned and thus the three Dutch priests of this city met their God.

"A native found their bodies and buried them. A Solemn High Mass at the site of their graves will be celebrated by a Dutch chaplain, an Australian priest and myself with ten other Australian chaplains as a choir.

"Our prayers for the three priests are belated but all the more fervent."

Prussian Prince, Convert, Freed

Spurred Catholic Life In Dachau Prison Camp

London — (UPI) — Among those who took an active part in Catholic religious life in the Dachau concentration camp, according to a report just received, was Prince Leopold of Prussia, grandson of Prince Heinrich, only brother of the late Kaiser Wilhelm II. Prince Leopold is a convert to the Catholic faith.

He had been engaged to a girl who was a member of a well-known Catholic family. When her parents refused permission for the marriage, the girl entered a convent. A short time later the Prince became a Catholic.

Details about the reason for his arrest by the Nazis are not known. Being a member of the Hohenzollern family and opposed to the Nazi ideas may have been his only "crime."

He spent time in several other concentration camps before being taken to Dachau, where he was liberated by American troops.

Beatification Cause Of Fr. Damien Advanced

Washington — (NC) — The Sacred Congregation of Rites has examined the report on the writings of Father Damien, "Apostle of the Lepers." This examination is one of the preliminaries in a beatification cause.

The chancellor of the Congregation of Rites at the Vatican has informed Father Philemon Lefever, Superior of the Fathers of the Sacred Heart seminary here, that the cause of Father Damien, the apostle of the lepers, is progressing. The task of collecting and publishing Father Damien's writings was entrusted to the Procurator General of the Fathers of the Sacred Heart, the missionary society to which Father Damien belonged.
