Dr. Benedict V. Favata, neurosurgeon on the staff of Strong Memorial Hospital will give the talk on "Science and Religion."

A sound motion picture "Prelude to D-day Invasion" will precede the principal speaker, Lt.-Col. Edward Harris II, who will present "The Problem of Getting Tanks and Bullets to the Fighting Soldier." A brief question period will follow. Colonel Harris who served in the European theater since 1942, has had wide experience in Army handling of supplies.

Meeting was arranged by Charles C. Mandia, retiring president and President-elect Henry H. Jensen and the executive committee. Official ritual for the inauguration of new officers will be followed for the first time.

A balanced spiritual and social program has been arranged for the men. Emphasis will be placed on attendance at the Nocturnal Adoration Society, First Friday Luncheon Club and Laymen's Retreat.

Parish activities include Boy Scout and Girl Scout Troop sponsorship, public speaking and discussion group, use of Missal and Dialogue Missal. A special committee will publish St. Anne's Service Bulletin, named weekly for the past six months.

Pope Pius XII gave a farewell audience to British Field Marshal Sir Harold R. Alexander, newly appoint-


