Freedom of Protestants Impaired by Concordat
Vatican City — (NC) — The signing of Concordat between the Holy See and Italy makes no mention of Protestantism, but solely regulates the relationship between the Catholic Church and the Italian State. It was pointed out here in comment on a telegram reported to have been sent by President Harry S. Truman to a Protestant body, advocating dissolution of the Concordat on the ground that it allegedly discriminates against Protestants in Italy. Furthermore, it was declared, Protestants in Italy are assured religious liberty under civil laws.

Circulation Rises Among Catholic Czech Publications

Prague — (NC) — A remarkable revival in the field of Catholic journalism, with many publications — three of them dailies — enjoying vast increases in circulation, has taken place in Czechoslovakia since that country's liberation.

The record increases in the circulation of Catholic publications are traced to the fact that an overwhelming majority of Czechs are conservative and democratic, looking forward to the reestablishment of a true democracy such as existed before the war and disliking dictator-

Msgr. Sheen in New Radio Role

Washington, Ind. — (NC) — Starting on October 4, the Rt. Rev. Msgr. Fulton J. Sheen, of the Catholic University of America, will speak each week on "The Spiritual Clinic," a coast-to-coast radio program to be produced by the Mutual Broadcasting Company in co-operation with Our Sunday Visitor, published here. The program will begin at 10:15 a. m. New York time, and will continue 15 minutes.

The pattern of the program was conceived by Monsignor Sheen. It will be informal and will consist of little human interest stories and anecdotes. Monsignor Sheen will appeal to his listeners to submit their problems for analysis and solution. He will discuss one or two of these cases on each broadcast.

Jewish People to Help Build Catholic Churches

London — (CP) — The Jewish congregation in Manhattan, Holland, whose contributions were virtually destroyed during the war, has contributed about \$200 toward rebuilding Catholic churches in the New York area. The gift was presented to Bishop Sheen, of the Archdiocese of New York, at a luncheon at the Waldorf-Astoria hotel.
