Australians To Ban Lurid Divorce News

Sydney, Australia — (RNS) — Plans for the New South Wales government to introduce legislation prohibiting publication of salacious evidence in divorce court cases has been greeted with satisfaction by Australian churchmen.

The proposed bill is patterned after similar measures in England, and in Victoria, South Australia, where press reports are restricted to names of the parties involved, the grounds for the petition, the result of the suit, and the remarks of the trial judge.

Poles Study in Exile

Lille, France — (NC) — Hundreds of students for the priesthood, most of them of Polish nationality, who have been liberated from German concentration camps, are now residing in Belgium, reluctant to return to their native countries. Many of them have been advised by their superiors to continue their theological studies abroad. These students never write to their relatives at home in order to spare them difficulties and dangers.

6 School Papers Win 'All Catholic' Honors

Milwaukee — Publications of four Rochester Diocesan high schools have been awarded six All-Catholic honors in the 1945 survey and rating conducted by the Catholic School Press Association.

Distribution of the awards was announced by Dean J. L. O'Sullivan of the Marquette University College of Journalism, Director of the Catholic School Press Association.

All-Catholic ratings were received by the following: The Sentinel, annual, DeSales High, Geneva; Achillean, annual, Holy Family High School, Auburn; Lantern, annual, and The Gabriel, newspaper, Nazareth Academy, Rochester; Mercedes, magazine, and The Quill, newspaper, Our Lady of Mercy High School, Rochester.

Annuals, magazines and newspapers are judged by the Association in college and high school divisions for diffusion of Catholic thought, enterprise and service to the school, editorial content, physical appearance, uniformity and consistency in style, headline construction and accuracy and application of art to news and features.

First Place awards of the International Quill and Scroll Society have been rated by The Quill, bi-weekly newspaper of Our Lady of Mercy High School. It is announced at the school.

For its outstanding contribution in publicity for the war effort, The Quill has received in addition the "A" Award given by the Society.

Mass in London Recalls Defense of Malta

London — (NC) — The outstanding part played by Malta, the British island in the Mediterranean and one of the most Catholic areas in the world, during World War II, came back to mind when her first metropolitan Archbishop, the Most Rev. Michael Gonzi, celebrated High Mass in Westminster Cathedral here in observance of Our Lady's birthday and of Malta's national holiday.

It was on this day 300 years ago that the Maltese under their commander La Valetta drove back to the sea the Turkish forces who had besieged the island for four months. Archbishop Gonzi, who thanked for that day's deliverance, was himself the hero of the more recent and more severe Maltese struggle during which he placed his life at least once a week when he crossed from the island of Malta to the neighboring island of Gozo.
