At St. Anne Hall**

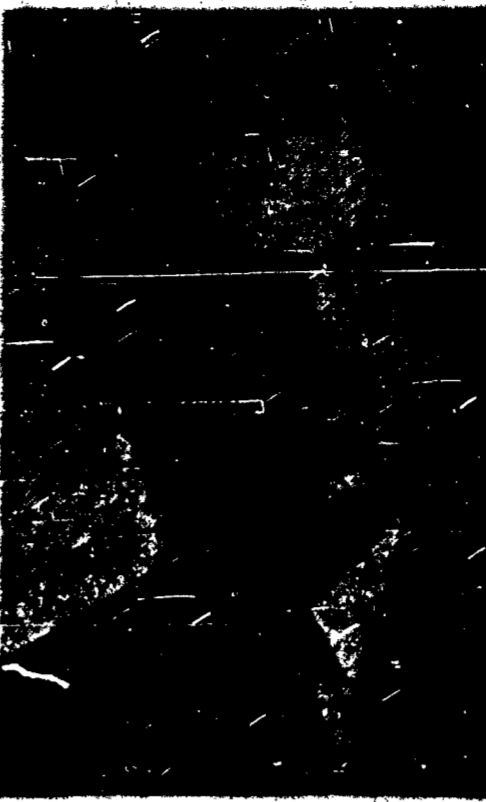
A Minstrel Show under the

superfluous. If the spirit of the  
Third Order flourishes in the parish  
it will heaven the whole parish,  
the pastor will notice that  
society, the most active mem-  
bers of his parish, the most loyal  
backers of every parish under-  
taking spiritual or temporal are  
members of the Third Order of  
St. Francis. The Pope  
has singled out St. Francis as  
the Patron of Catholic Action  
and the Third Order as the soul  
of Catholic Action. Once the  
Third Order receives wide-  
spread attention and the recog-  
nition which it has always re-  
ceived from the Pope, we shall  
see its power extend the world  
over and bring with it the  
peace and love which St. Francis

has brought to the world.
