New Orleans — (NC) — During his visit here His Eminence Jean Marie Rodrigue Cardinal Villeneuve, O.M.I., Archbishop of Quebec, offered Mass in the private chapel of the Most Rev. Jules B. Jeuneau, Bishop of Lafayette, visited De la Salle Normal School of the Christian Brothers, and was welcomed by ecclesial and civic officials at a

dinner given at the Evangeline hotel.

The following day His Eminence was taken on a tour of the Evangeline Country, so named in memory of the heroine of Longfellow's famous poem. The Cardinal's tour included a visit to the grave of Evangeline, by the side of St. Martin's Church, on the bank of Bayou Teche. It was recalled that it was in this section of the State that many exiled Acadians found refuge after the long and weary trip from Nova Scotia.

United Artists. Benedict Bogeus production based on celebrated pirate story with Charles Laughton as Captain William Kidd, Randolph Scott as Adam Merry and Barbara Britton as Lady Ann Falconer. Cut to current pattern of escapism and not so expertly done that audiences may not feel urge to escape. Laughton in usual blustering stride. Fairly effective backgrounds but sometimes tedious direction. Take or leave proposition.

"PRIDE OF THE MARINES" * (Adults) Warners. Experiences of U. S. Marine Al Schmidt, blind hero of Guadalcanal, tailored to suit film star John Garfield. Develops deep pathos but loses the spiritual value of true heroism in order to play Garfield true to screen type as "the man behind the eight ball." His attitude of bitterness and the typical Hollywood hokum which has him pretending no longer to love the fine girl (Eleanor Parker) who is waiting for him, breaks faith with fact. Some scenes in which wounded heroes discuss the future with a Communist chip on their shoulder further anchors to materialism, a theme that might have been uplifting to millions.


