

# Protests Radio Sex Teaching

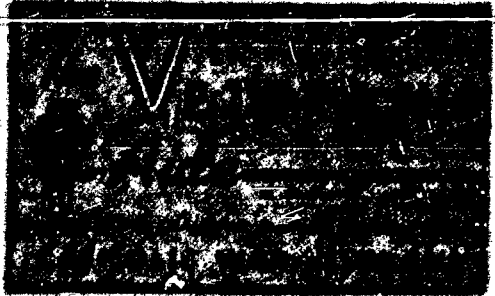
Sidney, Australia (RNS) — Proposals to broadcast talks on sex instruction over commercial radio stations were opposed here by the Most Rev. Matthew Beovich, Archbishop of Adelaide, in testimony before a parliamentary standing committee.

The Archbishop stressed that radio broadcasts would be heard

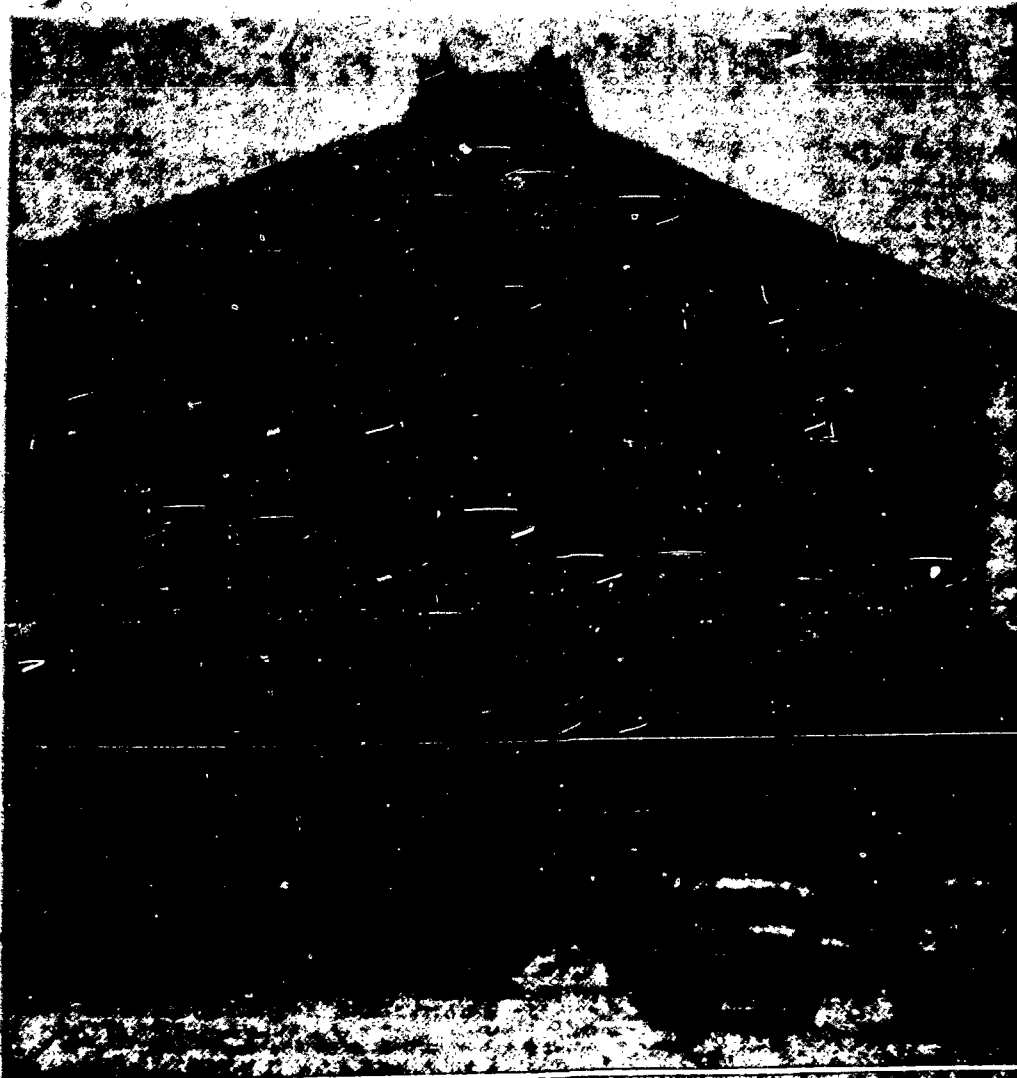
indiscriminately by children and youth of both sexes and members of the same family. He asserted that sex instruction should be given privately and prudently, and be based upon religious teachings inculcating purity.

Recalling that in the United States the War Advertising Council had abandoned a public campaign against venereal disease, in which radio talks were to be featured, Archbishop Beovich expressed hope that the Australian proposal would meet the same fate.

Q.—Is it true that a veteran is given preference for all Federal Civil Service positions? a vet of World War Two asks.

A.—The Veterans Preference Act of 1944 that a disabled veteran is to receive preference, without question (excepting positions that pay more than \$3000 a year). A passing grade would send him to the top of the list. About half of civil service positions are filled by women and it has been estimated that about 60% of the federal government positions pay \$1800 a year or less.

Q.—A veteran of WW 2 advised that while in the Navy he was awarded the Purple Heart. He has lost the medal and asks if he can get a duplicate?

A.—Yes, by writing giving your full name, your grade at time of discharge, time and place of your induction and discharge and your dog tag number to the Bureau of Naval Personnel, Washington 25, D.C.

Q.—My husband is serving with the Navy in the Pacific and our second son was born two months ago. Friends say that we can get an allowance for the new baby. Will you please advise me?

A.—Yes, and the allowance will be effective with the first day of the month your baby was born. Application for the baby's allowance may be made by the father or yourself. If you make it you should apply to the Bureau of Navy Personnel, Washington 25, D.C. and submit a certified copy of the child's birth certificate. Your husband may apply through regular Navy channels.

Q.—At present this veteran is receiving a disability pension from the Veterans Administration and he is establishing a small business and wishes to know if the VA will make his pension payments to settle his loan in the event his business should fail?

A.—No such deductions from pensions payments are made excepting only where the veteran is guilty of fraud. An honest failure is never penalized by VA.

Q.—Another veteran states that he intends to take advantage of the G.I. Bill educational provisions but wishes to commute daily to a college some 40 miles from his home. He inquires if the government will make an allowance for his monthly transportation?

A.—You must pay your transportation under the G.I. Bill. Only disabled veterans who receive vocational rehabilitation under Public Law 16 receive free transportation to schools that are a distance from their homes.

Q.—Is it true that an Army officer who has been released from duty and is home on terminal leave, must wear his uniform until his leave expires?

A.—No, a commissioned officer may wear his uniform or his civilian clothes while on terminal leave, after his release from service.

NOTE: Enlisted men and women should have a 30 day furlough prior to discharge. You can help by writing to your Congressman and asking him to support H.R. 2243 and your G. I. Sen. also asking them to support S. 2014. These bills would grant a 30 day furlough to enlisted personnel prior to their discharge. The bills are now in the Military Affairs Committee of the House and the Senate.
