### U. S. Chaplain to Present British Priest in Lecture

Preaching at Aquinas Auditorium Sunday evening when the Rev. Thomas Gilby, O.P., British Royal Navy chaplain, lectures on St. Thomas Aquinas, will be Lieutenant James Duffy, C.S.C., a Notre Dame alumnus now stationed at Sampson Naval Base after three years Pacific duty.

Arrived only last week from England, Father Gilby is brought to a Rochester audience through the Aquinas Christian Culture Lecture Series, founded and directed by the Rev. Hugh Hafler, C.S.B.

The Dominican chaplain, who is considered an authority on St. Thomas Aquinas, will discuss the timeliness of the learning of the great 13th Century philosopher. Title of the lecture is "Eternity Now."

A veteran of action in the invasions of Sicily, Italy and the Levant, Father Gilby is now attached to the British Embassy for a few weeks. He has served in the Royal Navy since 1938. Educated privately at St. Philip's Grammar School, Birmingham, Father Gilby holds a Doc-

torate from Louvain University. He was formerly professor of Speculative Morals at Oxford University. He is editor of "Blackfriars," learned British review, and author of "Poetic Experience," and "Morals and Marriage," over 50,000 copies of which have been sold in America. Like all other Christian Culture lectures, this event is open to the public. Tickets may be secured at the door.

A member of the 77th Bombing Squadron, he will enjoy a sixty-day leave after which he will report for duty at Greenville, S. C.

Corp. Dante P. Albino, son of Mrs. Caroline Albino, 37 Elm street, is currently stationed at Oglethorpe, Georgia, where he will spend two weeks before reporting to his new assignment in the United States.

Corporal Albino was returned recently to the States after having served thirteen months in England, France, Belgium, and Germany, as a tank gunner in the Armored Division. His decorations include the European Theatre of Operations ribbon with three campaign stars, the Purple Heart with Oak Leaf cluster and the Distinguished Unit badge.

### U. S. Lithuanian Group Thanked by Pope for Aid

New York — (NC) — A message of thanks from His Holiness Pope Pius XII has been received here by the Rev. Joseph B. Koncius, President of the United Lithuanian Relief Fund of America, for the society's gift of \$6,000, which was forwarded to the Holy Father through His Excellency the Most Rev. Amleto Cicognani, Apostolic Delegate to the United States, for assistance to Lithuanian refugees in Italy and France.

Plan Separate Monasteries Prague — (RNS) — Benedictine monasteries in Czechoslovakia are planning to sever administrative ties with German Benedictines, and to establish a separate jurisdiction. The question is being discussed with Vatican authorities in Rome and final approval is regarded as virtually certain.
