Visual Study of Industries Attracts 10,000 Students

Students in Catholic parochial schools of the diocese are currently learning about eight major American industries through a series of visual studies published and distributed by the Coca-Cola Company.

Sister M. Cecelia Marie, sixth grade teacher at St. Margaret Mary's school, Irondequoit, is typical of Rochester parochial school teachers who have successfully adapted the material contained in these studies to the curriculum.

She has employed various phases of this series entitled "Our America" in English and Art studies. While some of her students have made crayon drawings modeled on the illustrations "Our America," others have written compositions on the story material.

In the Rochester area, "Our America" is now being studied by more than 10,000 parochial and public school students from the fifth to eighth grades.

Author of the series is Dr. Frederick Houk Law, A.B., A.M., Ph.D., widely traveled educator and writer of thirty-five books on varied subjects. Dr. Law is editor of the Education Division of "Reader's Digest" and of "Popular Science Monthly."

The present series covers these industries: steel, oil, electricity, transportation, lumber, movies, cotton and glass.
