those expert masters of double-talk — the American Communists and the American Birthcontrollers.

The veil of silence which has cloaked Communist activity in this country for the past four years was rent this week by J. Edgar Hoover, able director of the FBI.

Speaking before a meeting of Police Chiefs in Miami, Mr. Hoover trained his verbal guns on the American Communists and labeled them as "panderers of diabolic distrust."

"The Communist Party," he warned, "is seeking to use the returning veteran as a new front behind which it can hide."

In an address to American Legion leaders at Indianapolis this week also, another FBI chief, Lee R. Pennington stated that "the Communist situation in the United States today is worse than it has ever been," and bluntly warned that "this group of rats has set out with the avowed purpose of infiltration into the American Legion."

"No individual," he added, "can be a Communist and take the oath of allegiance to the American Legion without reservation."

Admittedly the language of both Mr. Hoover and Mrs. Pennington is somewhat violent but these faithful sentinels of our national security are the men who defend America against the enemies who work in secret and under the cover of darkness.

The fact that FBI officials have broken silence at this time with forthright and vigorous warnings is a tipoff that the

menace of Red Fascism is not just scare talk but real.

In support of Mr. Hoover's warning let us recall the record of the American Communists.

In the early days of selective service and before Hitler doublecrossed Russia, our Reds were calling the American soldier a tool of imperialism.

The Reds sabotaged and obstructed our war production until the hour when the Hitler-Stalin honeymoon broke down.

If Hitler had attacked the United States instead of Russia our Red Fascists would have sent our soldiers into battle with no better weapons than broomsticks.

Our Moscow-inclined Reds who did not want to waste one American to defend England against Hitler were very willing to sacrifice millions of Americans in a premature and unprepared "second front" to save Mr. Stalin's dictatorship.

By their deliberate attempt to bait General Franco into a military alliance with Hitler, our unpatriotic Communists jeopardized our invasion of Africa and risked the lives of millions of American and British fighting men.

This is a sketchy record of those propagandists who have infiltrated, according to Mr. Hoover, our schools, labor ranks and even churches (non-Catholic, of course), and are now waiting their chance to convert to the Russian way of life the very men who fought for American democracy.

Another campaign designed to exploit the veteran, and just as unpatriotic as the Red plot, is that which stems from the New York headquarters of the Planned Parenthood Federation of America.

A new pamphlet specially prepared to indoctrinate returned war veterans with the tenets of "race suicide" is now being circulated among war chaplains by the Planned Parenthood Federation.

The chaplains are key figures in any veterans' group and as such they are supposed to place this vicious booklet into the hands of the returnee. Very smart public-relations strategy!

Accompanying this pamphlet to war chaplains is a letter on Planned Parenthood stationery and signed by Robert D. Workman, D.D. Presumably this is Rear Admiral Robert D. Workman (Presbyterian), who served as chief of Navy Chaplains from June, 1937 to July, 1944. A very clever!

In his promotion letter on the pamphlet Workman reveals that "The Library of Congress has thought well enough of the pamphlet to make it into a 'talking book,' available to all blinded returnees." What will the taxpayer and bond buyer say about this? Is our money going to promote anti-life movements under government sponsorship?

Remember how our boys went overseas to protect our children against Hitler? Remember how our boys gave their lives in support of our battle-front soldiers who begged for supplies and medicine?

The Planned Parenthood movement is an un-American conspiracy against the children and homes of tomorrow's America, and the high command of the Planned Parenthood Federation hopes to make the bones of the South and the bones of the West their place of ultimate resting.

Think of the brave Americans who died on Guadalcanal, Iwo Jima and France. Think of the veterans returning with great battle ribbons on their chests. How many of these honorable patriots would have been born if their parents had been indoctrinated by the Planned Parenthood movement?
