St. Bernard's Alumnus School Expansion In Chicago Mapped Dies in Louisville

Louisville — Tribute of the Archdiocese of Louisville to the 42 years of zealous, priestly and fruitful service of the Rev. John F. Knue, alumnus of St. Bernard's Seminary was paid at funeral services in Cathedral of the Assumption, Dec. 13.

Father Knue, pastor of Holy Trinity Church, St. Matthews, Ky., died Sunday, Dec. 9, 1945. The Most Rev. John A. Focher, Archbishop of Louisville officiated at the Pontifical Mass of Requiem.

The Rev. Joseph A. Vroman preached the eulogy. Final absolution at the grave was imparted by the Rev. Dr. Frederick J. Zwierlein of Rochester, a classmate of Father Knue.

Born in Yorkville, Ind., Oct. 12, 1878, Father Knue was ordained in Cincinnati, June 21, 1903. Coordinated to the Diocese of Louisville at the request of Bishop McCloskey, his first assignment was Danville where he had five churches under his charge. He established a new parish at McQuady going there in 1909. Sent to St. Columba Parish in Louisville in 1912 he later had charge of St. Elizabeth parish where school attendance increased from 390 to 1100 pupils.

He was to have become pastor of St. Vincent de Paul's church when stricken.

Father Knue is survived by three brothers, Louis H. Knue, Joseph W. Knue and Dr. George F. Knue, all of Indianapolis, and a sister, Mrs. Thomas Hughes, Washington, D. C.

Mexico City — (RNS) — Most of Mexico City's stores and offices were closed as thousands of pilgrims from all parts of the country joined in observing Guadalupe Day (December 12) in honor of Our Lady of Guadalupe, patroness of Mexico. This year Catholics commemorated the 400th anniversary of the apparition of the Virgin of Guadalupe to an Indian peasant, Juan Diego.

The famous shrine of Guadalupe nearby was thronged as devotees, many of whom wore Indian, dressed in picturesque costumes, showed their way to the foot of the crowned statue of the Virgin to present their offerings. Large numbers took to prayer as quantities of incense were burned in tribute to the Virgin.
