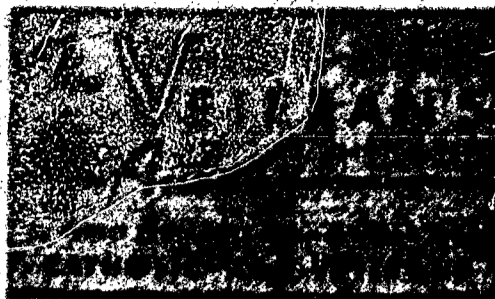


Holy Cross Missionaries Sail for Post in India

Washington, D. C. — (RNS) Five missionaries from Holy Cross foreign mission seminary have sailed from Hoboken, N. J. for India aboard the Liberty

ship Andrew Jackson. It was announced here. The missionaries will make their life work in Darca, Eastern Bengal. The traditional departure ceremony paralleling the sending by Christ of the Disciples to teach and christianize the world was held for them at the seminary here.

Q.—A wife writes that her husband is over 38 years and serving in the Navy and asks when he will be discharged?

A.—The Navy has ruled that all reserve enlisted men and women who are over 38 years and who had at least one dependent prior to August 15, 1945, are eligible for discharge. Wives count as dependents.

Q.—A vet of World War I states that while he was overseas for 18 months he suffered no injury. He is 57 years of age, suffering from high blood pressure and a heart condition. He asks if he is entitled to a pension?

A.—If your present ailment classifies you a total and permanent disability and prevents you from earning a living. We have mailed you Veterans' Administration form 526, which should be filled with a statement from your doctor as to your present condition.

Q.—An army nurse, on terminal leave, advises she wishes to obtain a position, as a nurse at a Veterans' Administration Hospital. She asks how to apply and what the salary is?

A.—Apply at the Veterans' Administration Hospital nearest your home. Former service nurses are given preference at VA-hospitals. The salary is \$3,200 a year, plus overtime.

Q.—A mother writes that her brother was drafted five months ago and as her mother is ill and the sister a cripple, he might be eligible to a dependency discharge. The family hesitates to make this request fearing that he will lose his veterans rights?

A.—Were your brother to make an application for an emergency dependency discharge and should same be granted, he would not lose any rights as a veteran. As he most likely is badly needed at home we suggest he apply for an emergency dependency discharge.

Q.—A reader asks if it is true that a veteran may attend a school in any section of the U. S. under the provisions of the G. I. Bill?

A.—Yes, in fact he may select a school anywhere in the world providing it has been approved by the Veterans' Administration, which pays tuition fees, for books, and subsistence. You would, however, have to defray your own transportation.

St. Bonaventure, N. Y. — (NC) — Eddie Mayo, star infielder of the champion Detroit Tigers baseball team, laid down a set of rules for 150 youngsters, who were guests of honor at the annual Olean Amateur Athletic League Banquet at St. Bonaventure's College, here.

Mayo, a Catholic who won the Sporting News magazine award as the American League's most valuable player last season, during his stay here was the guest of Father Anselm Krieger, O.F.M., a three-time All-American during his basketball playing days and a boyhood pal of the ball player. In his talk to the youngsters Mayo stressed an abiding interest in baseball, care of physical condition; self study and practice; obedience to parents and others in a position to guide them and, with deep seriousness, he emphasized: "Always keep faith with God."
