Final Tribute Paid To Sister Madeleine

Funeral services for Sister M. Madeleine Powers of the Sisters of St. Joseph were held at Nazareth Convent in Pittsford on Friday morning, Dec. 21. Solemn Mass of Requiem was celebrated by the Rev. W. Oscar Regan, C. S. B. assisted by the Rev. Roy Murphy as deacon and Rev. Thomas Manley as sub-deacon. The Rev. Joseph R. Gelell, Chaplain of Nazareth Convent, was Master of Ceremonies.

Present in the sanctuary were the Rev. Thomas Chapman, C. S. R., and the Rev. Edward Lutz. The blessing at the grave was given by Father Gelell.

Sister Madeleine was born in New York City, and entered the Sisters of St. Joseph in 1880. For a number of years she taught in various schools of the diocese among which were Nazareth Academy, St. Agnes' Institute, and St. Mary's in Comandara.

Her death occurred after a long illness at Nazareth Convent.

Surviving are a brother, Joseph Powers now residing in Rochester, a sister, Mrs. Mary Maydon of New Haven, Connecticut, two nieces, a nephew and several cousins.

Pope Thanked by New Chief Rabbi of Rome

Rome — (AP) — Pope Pius gave a private audience to Professor David Prato, newly appointed Chief Rabbi of Rome, who thanked the Pontiff for activities of the Catholic Church on behalf of persecuted Jews. Prato praised the Pope's successful intervention with German

authorities to prevent deportations of Jews from Rome during the Nazi occupation.

The Jewish leader stated that his immediate task is to reorganize the Jewish community in Rome, which has been reduced to a third of its original strength owing to persecutions and deportations.

Famed Stained Glass Restored at Chartres

Paris — (NC) — The Cathedral of Chartres has the most complete collection which remains of the art of stained-glass making of the twelfth century. Wisely, the glass enclosed in its windows was removed piece by piece at the outbreak of war and stored, partly in the Cathedral crypt and partly in acas in the center of France.

The glass has now been re-mounted in the windows of the Cathedral, and the faithful once more can admire the splendor of its colors, the secret formula of which has not been duplicated since the Middle Ages. Some of the windows were donated by King St. Louis and are consecrated to the glory of the Virgin.

Half Deportations British MP Warns

London — (NC) — Unless wholesale deportations and expulsions in Central Europe are stopped, the seeds of another war will have been sown, Richard R. Stokes, Catholic member of the House of Commons, declared at a mass meeting here, called to urge the British Government to increase food supplies to Europe. More than 5,000 persons were present.

Mr. Stokes said appeals have been addressed to the new regime of Czecho-Slovakia and Poland, and to the Soviet Union to stop deportations and expulsions. He declared "people cannot be uprooted in that way" and that it is against common sense, history and economics to try to crowd 65,000,000 persons into the new area of Germany, which is just a little larger than England.
