He became pastor of St. Theresa's Church, Stanley, Mar. 27, 1905, and was appointed pastor of Holy Cross Church in July 1913.

During his long tenure as pastor of Holy Cross, Father McCabe witnessed many changes in the lakeside area in which the

parish is located. Under his direction the present modern Holy Cross School was constructed in 1929 and more recently he guided the erection of a beautiful tower which completes the church edifice.

Father McCabe is survived by one brother and four sisters: Frederick T. McCabe of Syracuse; Miss Catherine and Miss Margaret McCabe, both of Auburn; Sister Alexandrine, S.S.A. of Corpus Christi Convent, Rochester, and Mrs. Christopher Demer of Rochester.

Mexico Education Bill Is Lauded

Mexico City — President Manuel Avila Camacho's request of Congress for amendment of Article 3 of the Federal Constitution to provide officially an education that will "develop harmoniously all the faculties of the human being" and will be based on a proper understanding of democracy, patriotism and international relations, has met with general commendation.

Regret is expressed, however, that the proposed amendment still leaves private schools at the mercy of the Government, retains phrases possible of narrow interpretation and bars religious from teaching.

Archbishop Luis M. Martinez of Mexico City, in a statement to the press, said: "The bill to amend Article 3 although it retains the hindrances to freedom of education incorporated in the Constitution of 1917, nevertheless constitutes an important step towards liberty because it clarifies principles and removes obstacles which as the result of the amendment of this article in 1934, disturbed the spiritual tranquility of the country."

"The orientation which the bill gives to education tends to procure the stability of the family, so important to society, to promote patriotism, a noble sentiment which will cooperate efficaciously towards national unity, and to place education in harmony with the present aspirations of humanity, which has learned a lesson from the war just ended."

With the advice and assistance of the Rev. John C. O'Donnell, pastor of St. Patrick's Church, Farrell then drafted an appeal to Commissioner Stockard who replied by ordering the Trustee to "proceed forthwith to provide transportation for elementary pupils residing within the district to the nearest parochial school and pay the reasonable cost thereof out of the funds of the district."
