Waverly Children Pick Up 961 Cans of Food

Waverly — In response to the diocesan appeal for food for the starving people of Europe and the Far East, children of St. James Church collected 961 cans of food, the Rev. Robert J. Fox reports.

The local drive was conducted in connection with the nationwide N.C.W.C. War Relief Services campaign. Food was sent to headquarters in New York City to be packed for overseas shipment.

Funds are rapidly piling up in

the current campaign to purchase vitally needed life-saving equipment in Waverly, officials have announced.

The drive was started as a memorial to Lt. John Coleman who was killed Nov. 4 when the car in which he was riding plunged into the Susquehanna River near Nichols.

Priest Dies Who Aided Titanic Sinking Victims

Wilkes-Barre, Pa. — (NC) — The Rev. Daniel W. McCarthy, 77, who was a passenger aboard the liner Carpathia when it rescued survivors of the Titanic in 1912, and with a fellow priest ministered to many of the disaster victims, died here after an illness that had forced his retirement as pastor of St. Aloysius Church, South Wilkes-Barre in September.


Father McCarthy was en route to Rome aboard the Carpathia when the ship veered from its course in answer to the distress signals of the Titanic. He gave up his cabin to survivors on the emergency return trip to New York.
