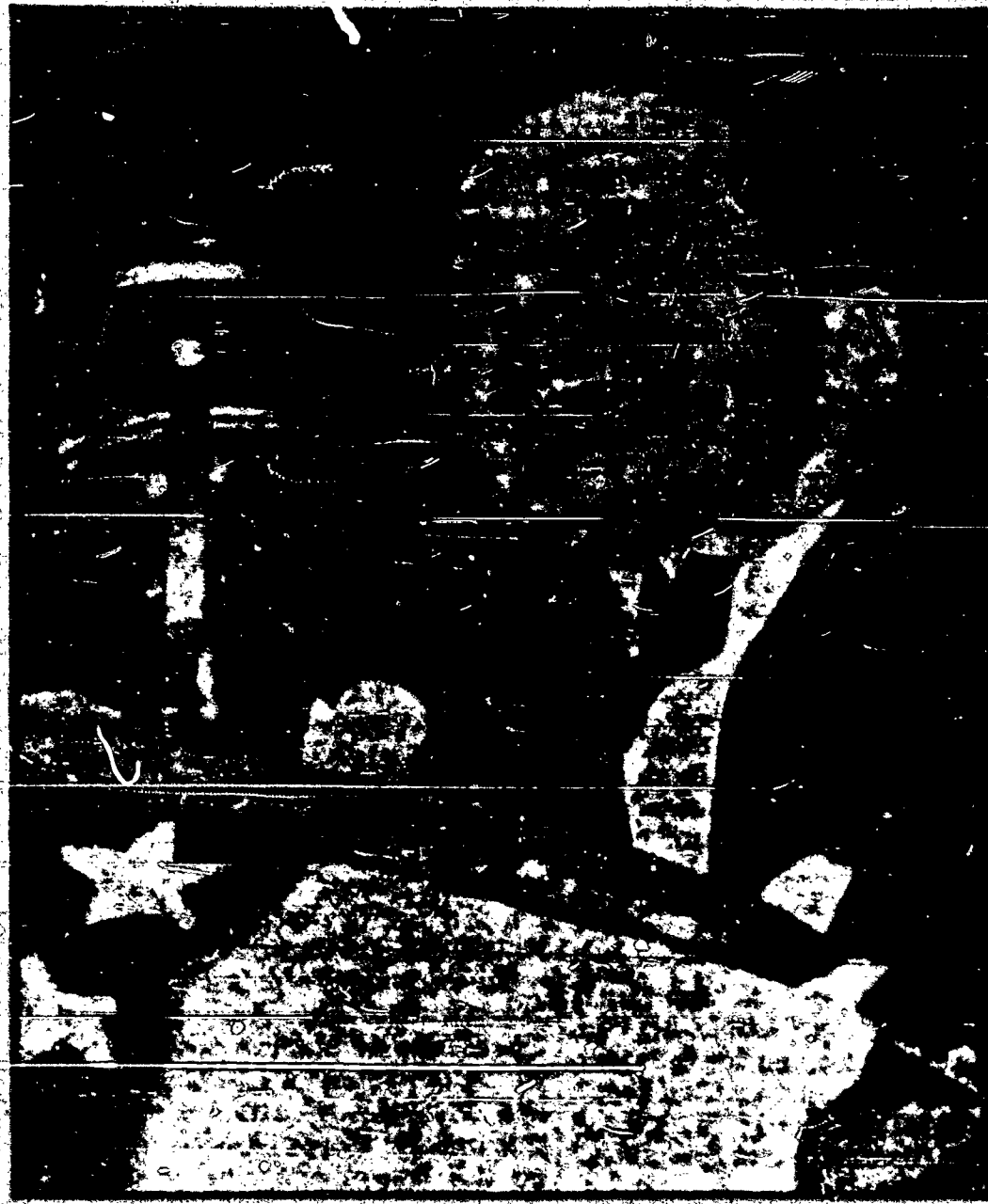


Friends of Frank Fay Counter Red Attack at Garden Rally

New York — An organized counter-attack against Communist propaganda was launched here on Thursday evening when 20,000 persons gathered at Madison Square Garden to attend a patriotic rally called by the "Friends of Frank Fay."

Included in the long list of speakers who addressed the huge Garden rally were C. G. Fenerty, judge of the Common Pleas

Court in Philadelphia, and Frank Fay, noted Broadway actor.

Strong criticism was leveled at Harold J. Laski, who was characterized as an "anti-religious bigot."

More than 20,000 boomed when the British Marxist was scored for his recent attack against the Vatican and the Catholic Church in Spain. His statements were branded as "Red Fascism."

Stalin, Russia, and the American Communists also came in for sharp condemnation from the speakers.

Judge Fenerty led the speak-

ers in urging Americans to "awaken to the menace of Communism" which he declared "threatens all religions."

"Laski's attack on religion," Fenerty said, "has disturbed England's chances of obtaining Congressional approval here of her proposed four-billion dollar loan."

"His attitude is typical of Red Fascism in action. Americans must remember that the Nazis and the Communists hate God. There is no difference between Brown and Red Fascism."

Frank Fay, star of the current Broadway stage show "Harvey," thanked the audience for supporting him in his fight against religious intolerance.

It was Fay's criticism of Laski's radio talk at a Red-sponsored rally last September that produced the now-famous case which saw the star of "Harvey" censored by Actor's Equity.

Appearance of five Equity members at the Red meeting brought a demand from Fay that their participation be investigated. Instead, Equity's national council reprimanded Fay and denied his request for a probe of Communism within the AFL organization.

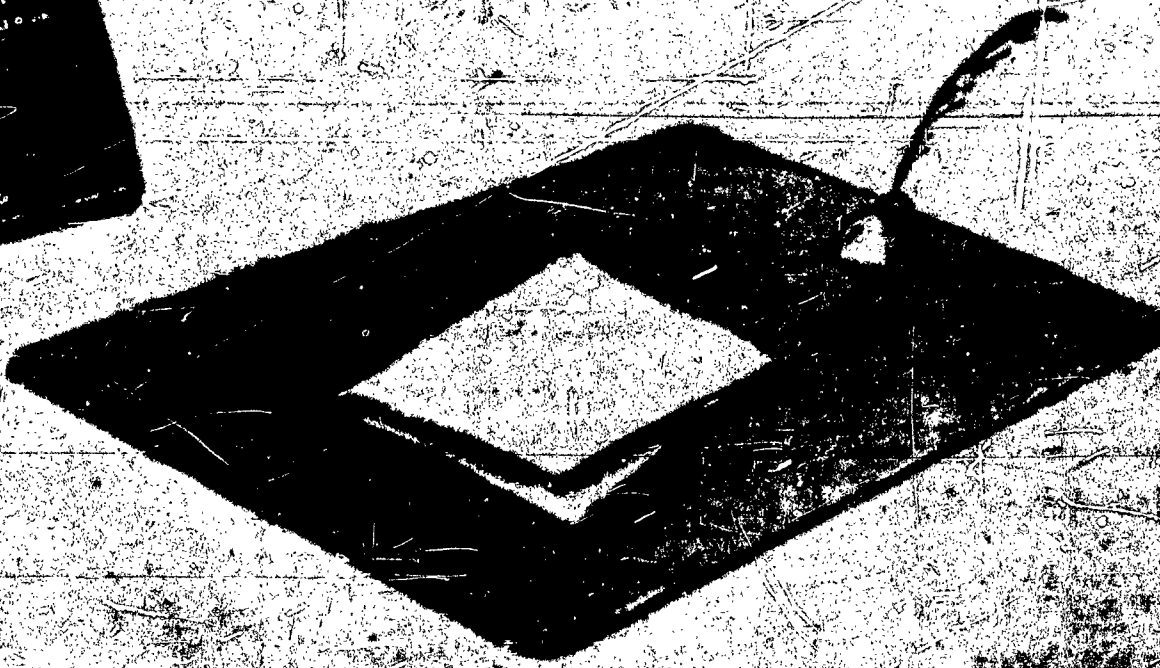
