### Catholic Theologians Form National Group

New York — Formation of a National Association of Catholic Theologians "to further the progress of theological science" and to bring the teachings of Catholic theology more effectively before the American public, has been announced here.

The new group first of its kind in this country was organized at a meeting sponsored by the theological faculty of the Catholic University of America, Washington, D. C. The meeting was attended by 38 priests who teach theology in 16 major seminaries and represented three dioceses and seven religious communities.

The Rev. Francis J. Connell, C. S. S. R. of the theological faculty of the Catholic University, was named temporary chairman of the Association, and the Rev. Joseph C. Fenton, professor of theology in the University and editor of the American Ecclesiastical Review, was elected secretary. (Father Fenton was formerly a member of St. Bernard's Seminary faculty in Rochester.)

The meeting appointed a committee to draft a constitution and by-laws. Another committee was set up to arrange for the first general meeting of the Association, which is expected to be held in New York at the end of June. The general meeting will also decide on the location of the Association's headquarters, and will elect a board of permanent officers.

### 'Bells' Stars Named Oscar Candidates

Hollywood — (INS) — The Academy of Motion Picture Arts and Sciences has announced official nominations for the 18th annual awards of merit to be voted upon by some 3,000 members of the film industry.

Announcement of the winners and presentation of the famous gold trophies, or "Oscars," will be made from the stage of Grauman's Chinese Theatre, in Hollywood, March 7.

Five films, five leading actors and actresses, five supporting performances, five directional and 15 writing achievements have been selected from the activities of 1945, from which will come the recipients of the coveted awards.

Three films were nominated as the best of 1945:

"Anchors Aweigh," "The Bells of St. Mary's," "The Lost Weekend," "Mildred Pierce" and "Spellbound."  
Bing Crosby was among five of the actors nominated. Others were Gene Kelly, Ray Milland, Gregory Peck and Cornel Wilde.
