

### Mits Honor Nun Who Served at Girls' Home

Funeral services for Sister M. Malachy, Mother of the Congregation of the Sisters of St. Joseph, were conducted in Holy Family Chapel at Nazareth Convent, Pittsford, on Saturday morning, Feb. 2.

Solemn Mass of Requiem was celebrated by the Rev. Cyril F. Carter, C.S.B., assisted by the Rev. Austin B. Hanna as deacon and the Rev. John D. Malley as sub-deacon. The Rev. Edward J. Lintz was master of ceremonies. Prayers in the sanctuary were the Rev. Joseph H. Gaffell and the Rev. Louis Zichman.

Interment was made in the Sisters' plot in Holy Sepulchre Cemetery, and the last blessing was given by Father Gaffell.

Sister Malachy died Thursday, Jan. 31, 1945, at Nazareth Convent, Pittsford, after a long illness. She was born in Ireland and entered the Sisters of St. Joseph in 1877. Most of her years as a nun she spent at St. Patrick's Girls' Home in Rochester, where for forty-three years she labored unceasingly caring for the orphans. The only survivors of Sister Malachy are several nieces.

### Exams for 9 Scholarships Set at Nazareth College

  - Major in Art, \$300 (\$200 a year)
  - 4 Partial Tuition Scholarships, \$400 (\$100 a year)
- Formal application should be made to the Dean before Feb. 15.
