A number of the smaller parishes exceeded and in some cases more than doubled their quotas at the first report meeting. These included:

Medal of Honor For Slain Hero

Award Goes to Father Of Luxon Paratrooper

Laredo, Tex. — (NC) — The Congressional Medal of Honor, awarded posthumously to Pfc. Manuel Perez, will be presented here to his father, Manuel Perez, Sr., by Gen. Jonathan Wainwright on February 22.

Pfc. Perez, a former member of St. Francis of Assisi parish, Chicago, was given the nation's highest honor for heroism displayed during the capture of Luxon.

The young soldier belonged to a parachute regiment planned down by heavy enemy fire on Luxon. In all he is reported to have knocked out twelve pill-boxes and killed 75 enemy soldiers in a heroic drive to save his buddies. One month later he was killed by a sniper bullet while on the road to Santo Tomé.

The hero's father has requested the War Department to send his son's body to Oklahoma City for burial, where the youth was born and spent part of his childhood years.


