Extends Welcome
 "We welcome you to Eire," replied de Valera, bending to kiss the Archbishop's ring.
 Archbishop Spellman, next he said to de Valera:
 "I bring greetings from Mayor O'Dwyer of New York."
 The crowd which had applauded de Valera at sight of the tall and dignified Glennon broke into outright cheers for New York's casual and simple mannered Archbishop and both men and women closed in about him as the Prime Minister kissed first the Spellman ring and then that

of Bishop Tien.
 "Don't knock down the airport cement is wet," Archbishop Spellman cautioned the people as they approached to kiss his ring and prepared to kneel while doing so.
Calls to Friend
 He was bareheaded, carrying his purple biretta in his hand, but he had on his black cassock with the purple piping and peaked at Canon Roughton of Ballynatoe, County Longford, who was in the Irish Seminary at Rome, when Archbishop Spellman was studying for the priesthood in the American College there. The two shook hands with vigor.

An cameramen took pictures of the arrivals, including former Postmaster General Farley and ex-Mayor McKee, the crowd began singing a chorus of "Killarney."

Irish-born Archbishop Glennon and Archbishop Spellman joined by the Chinese Cardinal-archbishop Tien, who speaks little English to say nothing of Gaelic, could only cock an ear and smile.

The Prime Minister immediately drove Archbishop Spellman to St. John's Cathedral in Limerick, where he said Mass and in a talk to the congregation observed:

"Eire is a natural stop on the way to Rome, for in all matters pertaining to religion the Irish look to Rome. This has been part of the history of the race ever since that Holy Saturday morning when St. Patrick, bearing his mission from Pope Celestine II, the Easter fire on the Hill of Slane.

"We are pilgrims on our way to Rome, to the Eternal City where is the Rock on which the Church is builded, the Rock that is unshakable, against which no evil power will prevail.

"We are privileged to stop in Ireland where we are inspired by the allegiance of the Irish to the Holy See, to the successor of St. Peter. The example of our own."

Archbishop Spellman told his listeners that "a large number of us who arrived at Rineanna Airport this morning" were descendants of Irish immigrants in the United States.
