

**Czechs Send Envoy  
To the Holy See**

Prague — (INC) — Appointment of Dr. Francis Schwarzenberg as chargé d'affaires of Czechoslovakia at the Holy See has been announced by Jan Masaryk, Czechoslovak minister of foreign affairs.

Dr. Schwarzenberg, who is 23 years old, is a member of one of the oldest aristocratic families in Bohemia, which has furnished many prominent statesmen. He served with the Czech underground during the German occupation and his property was confiscated by the Gestapo.

**First Two U. S. Cardinals  
Given Red Birettas in U. S.**

Washington — (INC) — The action of His Holiness Pope Pius XII in delegating Papal Nuncios to impose the red birettas upon the two Cardinals-designate who are unable to go to Rome for the Consistory, recalls the fact that the first two American-resident Cardinals and the first Canadian Cardinal received their introduction to the Sacred College in a similar manner.

The first American Cardinal, Archbishop John McCloskey of

New York, received the first official word of his elevation in March, 1873, in a cablegram from the Papal Secretary of State. He was notified that Pope Pius IX, in the Consistory of March 15, had preconized him a Cardinal; that two Papal representatives would bring him the official notification and cardinalatial insignia, and that the Archbishop of Baltimore was to impose the red biretta.

Count Mavrogheni of the Noble Guard, dressed in his colorful uniform, delivered the biretta, or document of notification, and the zucchetto, or red skull-cap, on April 26. The next day, in St. Patrick's Cathedral, the Papal Alegate and bearer of the red biretta, Msgr. Roncetti, read the Brief of the Holy Father, and Archbishop James Roosevelt Bayley imposed the biretta.

America's second Cardinal, Archbishop James Gibbons of Baltimore, was elevated by Pope Leo XIII in the Consistory of June 7, 1886, along with Canada's first Cardinal, Archbishop Elzear-Alexandre Taschereau of Quebec. Two Papal representatives were sent by fast steamer arriving in New York June 21, and that evening were received at the archiepiscopal residence in Baltimore. (The biretta had arrived by mail on May 18.) Count Muccilli of the Noble Guard presented Cardinal Gibbons with the zucchetto and Msgr. Straniero, the Alegate, announced that the red biretta would be conferred on June 30, the 25th anniversary of the new Cardinal's ordination.

Nearly the whole American Hierarchy was present when Archbishop Peter R. Kenrick of St. Louis, representing the Holy Father, bestowed the red biretta upon the new Prince of the Church. Nine months later Cardinal Gibbons journeyed to Rome to receive the Red Hat from the hands of the Pope and took possession of his titular church. In the meantime, Cardinal Taschereau received the red biretta in ceremonies at Quebec, July 21, 1886.
