### Verein Speaker Lists Conditions For Peace Return

If there is going to be peace there must be a beginning by a return to God and His law, the Rev. Charles Guttenberger, C.S.S.R., said in addressing a joint meeting of Rochester Branches, Catholic Central Verein of America and National Catholic Women's Union in St. Joseph's Hall, Sunday.

To effect peace, the speaker said in explaining two sections of the "Will For Peace" declaration adopted at the national convention and headed "Social Charity" and "Social Justice," there must be a renewal of morals of nations. "Then let social justice come into play giving individuals and nations their due and respect the rights of others," he said.

"Introduce Social Charity providing individuals with what they need according to their human dignity out of one's abundance. Provide nations in need with the riches and abundance of the world and because God is our Father and we His children."

**2957 Army Chaplains Out** Washington, D.C. — (NS) — A total of 2,957 army chaplains have been returned to civilian life since September 1, 1945, it was announced here by the office of the Army Chief of Chaplains. The same report pointed out that there were 5,184 army chaplains on duty as of last January 31, and that 1,342 chaplains had received 1,777 decorations as of that date.
