

Fr. Casey To Recount Vatican Trip for Club

Members of the Catholic Women's Club will hear the Rev. Lawrence B. Casey, pastor of Holy Cross Church give his impressions, as an eye-witness, of the solemn creation of 32 Cardinals at Vatican City, when he addresses them on Monday evening, March 18 at 8 p. m. at the Clubhouse.

(Adults) MGM. Based on a story by Blanche Bruce, adapted by De Vallon Scott and Alan Friedman, this is reminiscent in theme of "Love Letters." "Wolf" Larson (John Carroll), six foot soldier Lothario, finds a note in his army shirt. It's from Evie (Masha Hunt) who works in the shirt factory. John McPherson (Hume Cronyn), the "Wolf's" funny-soldier buddy replies, thus starting a correspondence Evie believes is with the handsome six-footer. Complications arise when the soldiers arrive in Evie's home town. Eventually Evie discovers she's really more fond of the little soldier than his impressive looking friend. There is neat underlying defense of character versus the physical as a consideration in romance. Although at times unconvincing and somewhat flippant in its approach to marriage, this makes good light entertainment with Hume Cronyn acting circles around the rest, even though the whole cast is good.
