

# 'Reeducation Camps' Open In Siberia for Russians

Rosse — (CIP) — Special "re-education camps" have been set up by the Soviet Government for Russian prisoners and deportees returning from other countries. These camps, whose inmates are completely isolated from the rest of the population, are mostly in Siberia, according to information given a CIP Correspondent by a person who receives frequently direct news from the Soviet Union.

The duration of reeducation in these camps is indefinite.

The Soviet authorities are apparently worried over the fact that the returning Russians have seen abroad many things which Communist propaganda tried to hide from them and that even the very modest luxuries of some of the Central European nations impressed them as vastly superior to the standard of living of the common people in the Soviet Union.

According to the interviewed person, comparisons with conditions abroad have already caused a wave of discontent in Russia. He believes, however, that

the Kremlin will be able to suppress this discontent as it has done successfully in many other cases.

## Cardinal in Warning On Spain Meddling

Rosse — (By Wire)(RNS) — A warning against interference in Spain's internal affairs was sounded by Bernard Cardinal Griffin, Archbishop of Westminster, in an interview here.

Expressing regret over attempts to intervene in Spanish questions "by means of revolutionary upheavals," Cardinal Griffin, who is the youngest member of the Sacred College, said such efforts "can only impede and retard the world's difficult progress toward reconstruction." He also urged that Italy be given "a generous peace" which will enable her "once again to take her proper place as a bulwark of civilization."

Discussing conditions in England, Cardinal Griffin asserted there is no antagonism or incompatibility between the Roman Catholic Church and the British Labor Party. He said "there are plenty of labor members in parliament who are Catholics and many of our leading laborites were educated in Catholic schools."

## Polish Commander Denies Troops Yugoslav Threat

Rosse — (INS) — Russian charges against Polish troops in Italy are described by Polish General Wladyslaw Anders as "part of a simultaneous Kremlin offensive against the British in Greece, Syria, Lebanon and Indonesia." The Polish commander flatly denied Russian-backed Yugoslav assertions that his troops were a threat to Yugoslav border security.
