**More U. S. Aid to Rebuild
Philippine Churches Asked**

Washington (NC) - Recem-
mendations for changes in the
Philippine Rehabilitation Bill to
provide more equitable help to
the Church in the Philippines
have been made here in a state-
ment by William F. Montavon,
director of the Legal Department,
National Catholic Welfare Con-
ference, who represents the rav-
aged islands' Catholic Welfare
Organization.

vided for the reconstruction of
Catholic schools and hospitals
and other charitable institutions
as a part of a public works pro-
gram, but churches and parish
houses must pool their claims
to participate proportionately in
a \$5,000,000 fund set aside for
them.

Mr. Montavon asked that the
committee strike out the \$5,000,
000 limitation on aid to churches
and church property of a purely
religious nature. He urged an
amendment "to give to religious
organizations in the Philippine
Islands the consideration at least
that is given to industrial and
commercial enterprises."
