

UN Saved Face—But Did It Save Iran?

New York—The United Nations Security Council saved its face, but it is far from certain that it saved Iran.

As one delegate after another congratulated the Council on having weathered the Russian boycott, one forgot the tiny, bird-like figure of Russian Ambassador Malinitski, perched at the end of the Council table.

The Iranian Ambassador must have felt at times like Alice in Wonderland. (I am reminded of Alice because of the "Alice in Wonderland" script chronicling her adventures in the other day.)

Over Soviet protests, the Council had, indeed, accorded Iran a hearing. But that should hardly justify the chorus of self-congratulation which filled the microphone.

It was the Australian contention that the Iranian case was a challenge to the Council's right to act. It was the conviction of the observer, who was trying to think for himself despite the wave of self-congratulatory prepared speeches of the nine other delegates, that the Australian veteran of Gallipoli was right.

Contempt Charges Face 'Anti Fascists'


