# U. S. Policy in Austria Draws Criticism Here

WASHINGTON—Although much has already been said about the failure thus far to restore a truly free Austria, it is expected here that this first victim of Hitlerian aggression will come more and more to public attention, as additional news reports and greater numbers of returning American soldiers reach this country.

The Allies are bound by their word, as witness the Moscow Declaration, to restore Austria as an independent nation. A great deal of the blame for the failure in that respect has been laid at the door of Soviet Russia, which has been charged with persistent resistance to restoration of Austria's political and economic independence. At the same time, it would not be surprising here if some sharp criticism were to be leveled against this country's actual policy in Austria.

Through information reaching here from Austria and talks with soldiers returning from duty there, one is likely to get two very definite impressions. One of these is that the rule of military in the Allied Control Council in Austria is operating, in effect, like the veto power of

sorted "Liberals" are being pushed forward and placed in positions of prominence, although they do not enjoy the popular support of the Austrian people themselves.

In connection with the first impression, some observers of the Austrian scene contend that there are many subjects upon which action is lacking because of the unanimity rule, which actually means Russian approval—is not needed in these cases.

The Russian, these observers say, frequently go along with a course of action they want to pursue, and ask approval afterwards. If the Americans would act independently and vigorously in those matters that do not require unanimity, it is said, they would soon have the British and French following their lead, and the Russians eventually doing the same.

# Cathedral Visit Converts Shipper

Lisbon — (NC) — An American Merchant Marine captain, Commander Daniel Austin Gelliksen, was so impressed when he attended the consecration of the Cathedral of Lourenco Marques, Portuguese East Africa, in 1944, that he decided to take instruction in the Catholic Faith and was baptized in the Cathedral on Christmas Eve of that year.

Commander Daniel Austin Gelliksen, of Brooklyn, N. Y., has served in the Merchant Marine since early in the recent war and visited Lourenco Marques on two occasions in 1944. The first visit was in August, 1944, when Commander Gelliksen was Master of the Victor Herbert. In late December, 1944, he returned to Lourenco Marques as Master of the Irving Rabbit. Building of the Lourenco Marques Cathedral was commenced by His Eminence Teodosio Clemente Cardinal de Gouveia, shortly after he was named Archbishop of Lourenco Marques in 1943.

# Fax Romana Backs Papal Peace Plan

LIMA, Peru — (NC) — A determination to study and accept the papal teachings on international peace, "regarding them and adhering to their practical application," highlighted resolutions adopted at the 10th Inter-American Assembly of Pax Romana here.

"We acknowledge the peace plan of the Holy See," the delegates declared, "as the expression of the authoritative teaching of the Church, capable of solving international relations through justice, promoting the spiritual characteristics and the rights of their people, in accordance with justice and equity."

A resolution of the assembly of the Holy Father was read at the opening meeting of the assembly, which brought 250 delegates from the Western Hemisphere and several European countries. Three delegates from the United States and four from Canada, including the Rev. John J. Ryan, S.J., president of Pax Romana, were present.

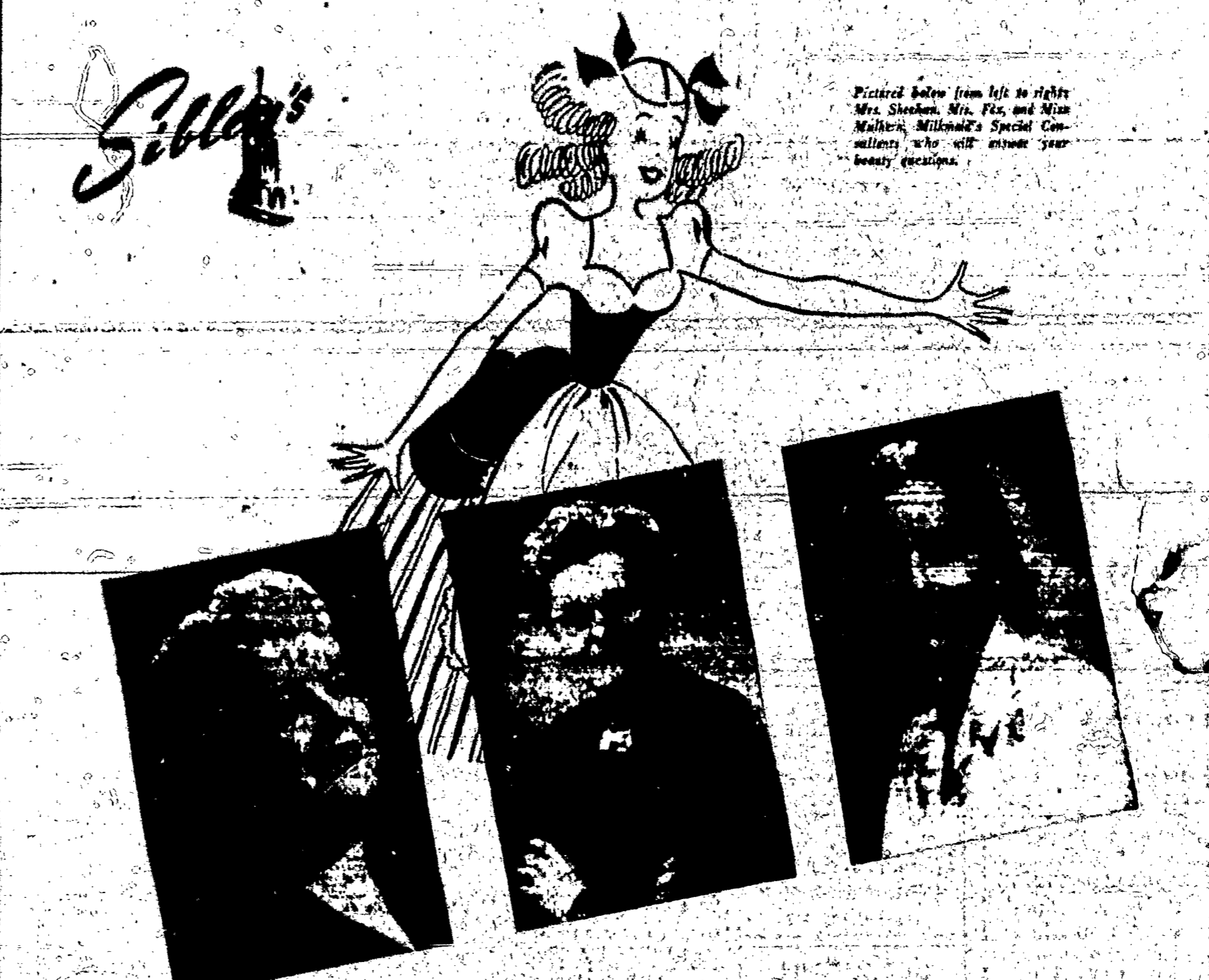
