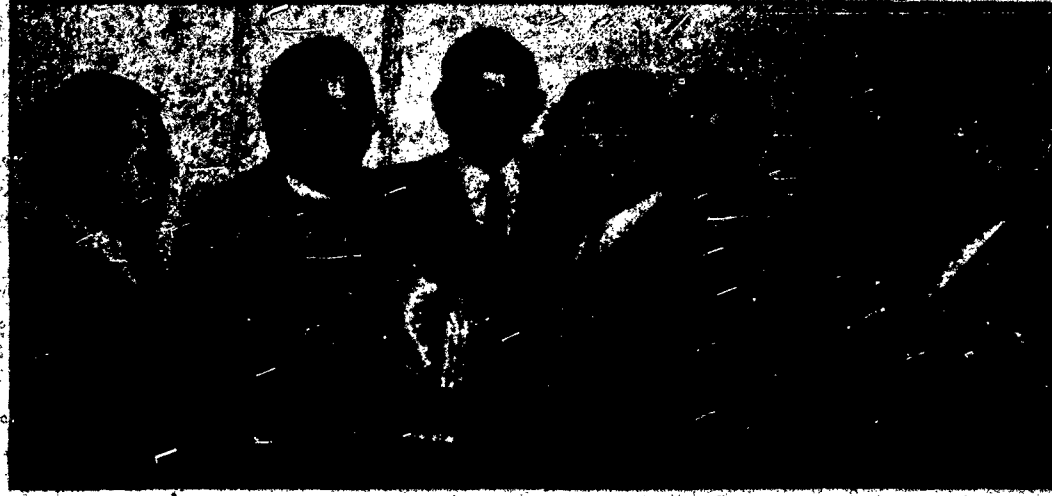


### Church, K. C. Bowling Leagues Elect Officers
