BY REV. ALBERT J. SHANNON. It has often been said that this is a man-made world. And that means just that, viz., that the world in its economic, political and social institutions and structure has been fashioned for men rather than women...

Perfection means completeness. A complete thing is a perfect thing and vice versa. A perfect thing is a complete thing. A bicycle with one wheel missing is imperfect because it is incomplete.

So it is with society. It attains its cultural perfection only when it is complete, i.e., when the men and women who make up society contribute the things that are peculiar to the different sexes. When a man, for instance, gives to society the things that only a man can give, and a woman the things that only she can give, for God made man male and female, i.e., different but complementary.

But if women become just like men, how can they enjoy what is wanting to man? Trusting after the mirage of equality, lured by the siren of false emancipation, slavishly imitating man even to the abandonment of the home, the world is being robbed of that part of its culture without which it ceases to be a fit place to live in.

What is a man without a heart? What is a home without a mother? These are the words that a world in which women cease to be women.

On May 25th the so-called Congress of American Women (about which we shall have more to say in the coming weeks) stated among its objectives the abolition of the home as "the last remnant of the handicraft era."

Our hope is that women will be sensible of the world interest in what year the earliest part of the house was built, but all existing evidence points to about 1045.
