New York (NC) — The encouraging sight of rows upon rows of canned goods destined for the starving war victims of Europe met the gaze of His Eminence Bernard Cardinal Griffin, Archbishop of Westminster, on a visit to the warehouse of War Relief Services-N.C.W.C. before his departure by plane for London.

Cardinal Griffin ended his two-week stay in the United States on Wednesday, May 22, when he boarded a plane for London.

Three Million Pounds of Food On Way to Europe

New York (NC) — With handling time out to a minimum, more than three and a quarter million pounds of canned food-stuffs have already been processed and loaded for shipment to seven countries as a result of the recent "Food for the Children" campaign conducted by War Relief Services-National Catholic Welfare Conference.

At campaign headquarters here it was learned that 2,000,000 more pounds of food have now been put on the way to European countries in addition to 1,250,000 previously sent to Poland, Italy and Greece.

The original national goal of 20 million pounds has been exceeded by 50 per cent, with a total of 30 million pounds reported by 118 dioceses.
