London, Aug. 1.—(UPI)—A British court has ordered the immediate opening of the ballot boxes to determine whether or not the voting was fair. The official returns, however, gave the Labor Party a majority of 1,134, No. 244. Departing Maryknollers Seen U.S. Good Will Envoy

Newark, N.J.—(UPI)—Maryknollers as well as Americans have divine depths and the destiny of America today is in line with the needs of the Church throughout the world. This attitude was expressed by Archibishop Edward J. Conaty of Newark, who gave a group of 20 American missionaries at the Maryknoll Seminary, New York, a special blessing. The seminary, founded by priests of the Society of Maryknoll, delivered the blessing of guidance to the American missionaries.

The group, with 14 priests and three brothers who are leaving the United States for the Orient, will minister at various universities. They are reported to their foreign posts. Of particular interest was the news of four priests who are leaving for Africa, which marks the third such departure announced by the seminary. Archibishop Conaty said: "Africa is a great country. And, I am sure, you will find your work among the native peoples very difficult. There will be many difficulties, still they are the finest possible representatives abroad of your nation; you are the most outstanding good will ambassadors." "For when you do your own work as Catholic missionaries you will win more friends than Americans, who are not yet fully converted to our cause," he said.

"Some of you are going to work among peoples frightened by the military and scientific power of America," he continued. "There will be resistance by your government and your church. Some of you are going to work among peoples treated and sometimes antagonized by the usual conduct of a few who identify themselves as typical Americans; there will be efforts to destroy your integrity and example. Some of you will work among people hardened and may God forgive us, accidentally destroyed by our diplomacy; and our vestiges; these will feel fresh confidence in us and conceive new friendship for our nation; as you witness your unusual services and the heroic dedication with which you contribute self to serve them. Whatever you do will make a tremendous spiritual contribution to the independence of America and give in the world."
