Hungary Recalls St. Gerard's Death

St. Gerard, who came here from Lombardy when St. Stephen was king and who served as tutor to St. Kirov, only son of the king, was canonized on Sept. 24, 1090 by a band of armed knights. Through into the marshes of the Danube, his body was recovered by the faithful and buried in the crypt of the Church of St. Mary, present city church of Pust. Seven years later the body was transferred to the Cathedral of Conant, episcopal seat of St. Gerard's diocese.
