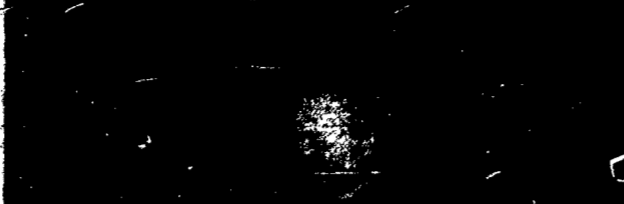
Newly elected president Louise Merrick presided at the business meeting which followed a welcome by Miss Marie...

KEEP DEMOCRACY POPE TELLS SWISS

Yveton City — (Radio, NC) — The people of Switzerland have every right to be proud of their democracy, because it is not an "artificial construction" but the "well-ripened fruit of centuries of experience," His Holiness Pope Pius XII said in a message to Switzerland, the text of which was published by Osservatore Romano.

The Holy Father's statement, which was broadcast over the Swiss radio, reminded that true liberty, as it rings in Switzerland, has need of "just limits" and that the rules of equity and "absolute respect" for the sovereign will of God, regarding marriage and family life, must be strictly adhered to in order to safeguard the common good of the people.

"I believe that even in our time," the Pope said, "when atheism like terrorism is being secretly, but surely, into the foundation of states, the world has need of hearts raised on high, in order to maintain its support and equilibrium."

"In addition as well as in private life the world has need of believing, praying Christians. In these times, in which we are witnessing great dangers and retractions of civilization, it is of the utmost importance that we should be united in prayer, in which, one after the other, they turn the risk of annihilation, remember that in order to preserve pure and intact the flower of humanity which does honor to your institutions and your customs, you need those superior forces which the Christian faith is alone capable of giving to peoples and to individuals."
