Cyprian Hofmeister, O.S.B., Abbot of Maria Theresia monastery in Bavaria, last was at St. Vincent's Archdiocese here. That was back in the mid-20's when he served as professor of modern languages in the seminary department and did parish work at Crabtree, Pa. He tried to get here for the centennial celebrations of the founding of the "Monte Cassino of America," but had weather prevented. Anyhow, he's here now for a visit and to revive old memories. Incidentally, it was the Bavarian monastery which Abbot Hofmeister now governs that Father Roscoe Finner led a century ago and came to this country, where he founded St. Vincent's.

As early as 1938 he was hurried off to jail by the Gestapo for refusing to disclose the whereabouts of two conferees, who fled to this country. He was arrested again in 1944, imprisoned a year in Berlin and another year at the dreaded Dachau camp.

Strangely enough, Abbot Hofmeister held that conditions at the less publicized Berlin jail were worse than those at Dachau. He said: "After a year in the Berlin prison I had lost 50 pounds and my vision was impaired by the dim light of my cell, which was tiny and damp. When I was transferred to Dachau, it seemed like heaven compared to the Gestapo jail in Berlin, because once more I could enjoy the fresh air and the light of day." "My prison master at Dachau," he recalled, included the famed Pastor Niemoller, who occupied a cell next to mine. The guards in our section were much easier on us, for the war was rapidly coming to a close. After two full years of imprisonment I received my discharge and was ordered to report to the local police at Mitten upon my return to the Abbey.

Socialists, Reds Favored
Asked about present conditions in Bavaria, he said: "The American military officers are, as a rule, very helpful, but there are unfortunate conditions arising from the policy of branding all Germans who were members of the Nazi Party before May 1947 as denazified. And overlooking party affiliations after that date. Some of the most zealous Nazis were the intensely indoctrinated youth who were too young to join the party until after May 1937. On the other hand, there were thousands who joined because it was disastrous not to join."

"To make matters worse," the Abbot continued, "socialists and communists are shown special favor by occupation forces. The Christian socialists, who polled 70 per cent of the votes in the last election, face considerable official opposition. "Economic conditions are terrible. Many active Bavarians are unable to get jobs because of nominal membership in the party, while Prussian migrants from southern Germany get jobs because no one is able to prove any party affiliation against them. As a result some of the best and highest paid posts in the government now are in the hands of men who formerly were professional criminals."

Madrid — (RNS) — Enrique Cardinal Primate of Spain, will shortly visit the United States, it was disclosed here. He will be accompanied by the Most Rev. Rodrigo Casan, Bishop of Barcelona. The Spanish primate is expected to attend the eighth annual congress of the Comintern of Christian Doctrine scheduled to open in Boston on October 25. It will be his first visit to the United States. Among those who will greet the primate are Francis Cardinal Spellman, Archbishop of New York, Archbishop Richard J. Cushing, Archbishop of Boston, and Archbishop Angelo Giovanni Cossato, Apostolic Delegate in the United States. Pope Pius XII has received in audience at Castelgandolfo, papal summer residence, Admiral Adaro A. Maffei, secretary of the U.S. Embassy in Madrid, now on an official European tour; Viscount Forrest P. Sherman, and Lieut. Gen. John C. H. Lee.
