

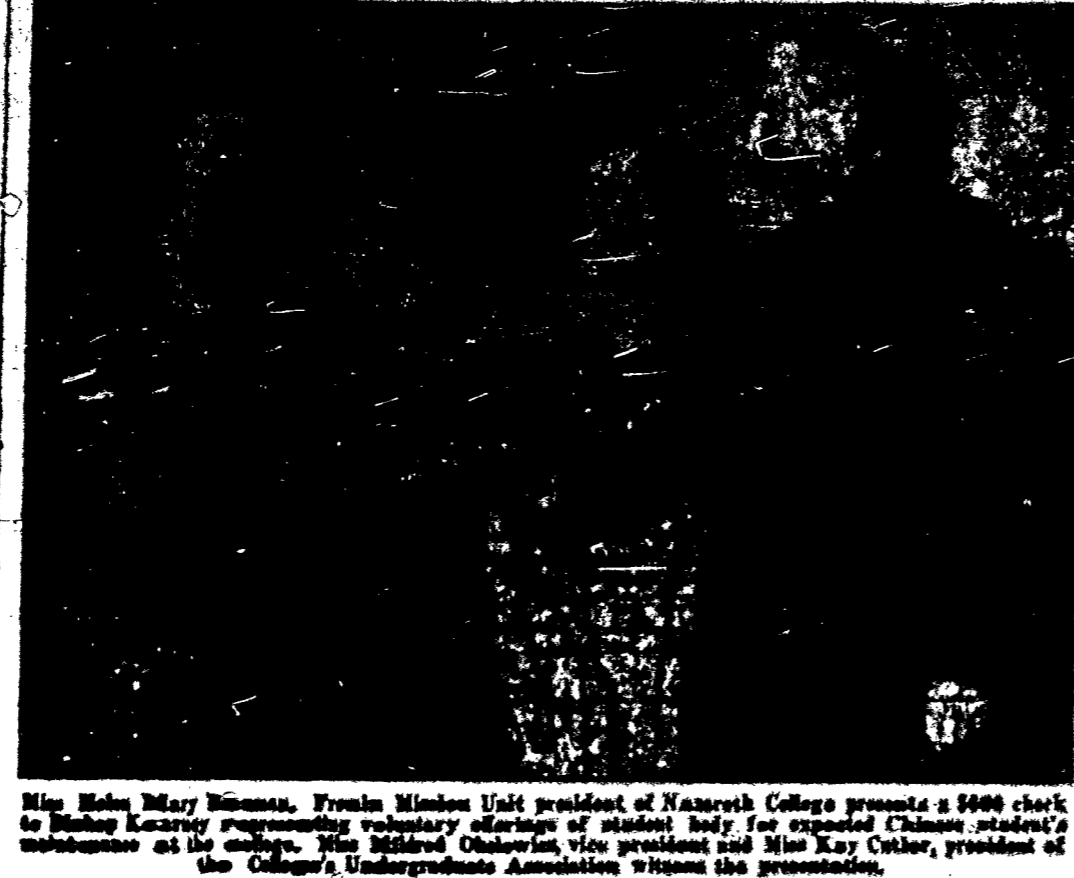
College Mission Unit to Hold Family Field Day
