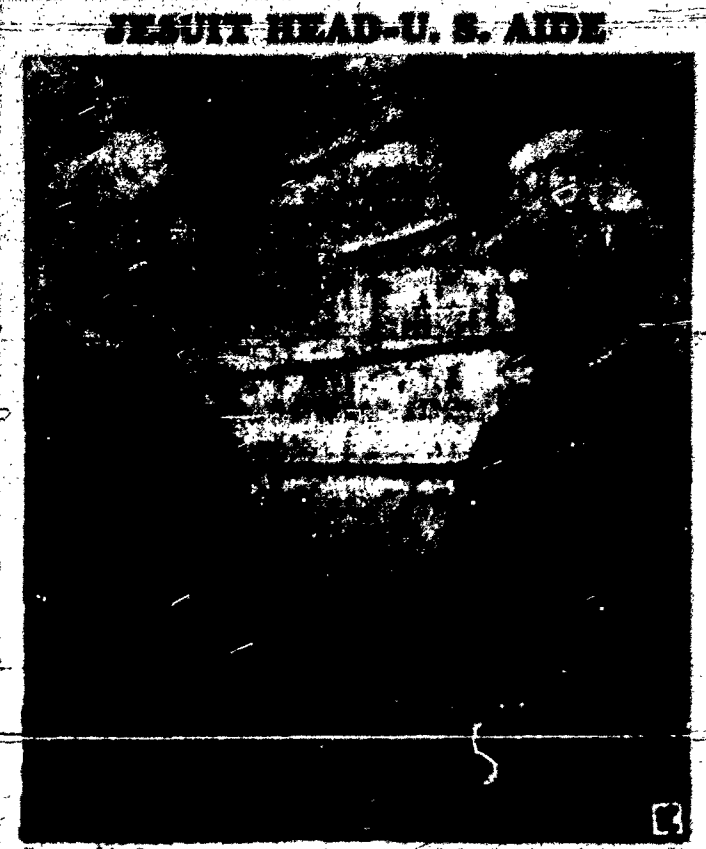

Bishop to Take Supplies to India
 New York — (NC) — Bishop Louis L. R. Moreau of Erie, Pa., preparing to return to his diocese after spending a year in the United States, will take with him all the cheap light cloth, shirts and underclothes, hosiery, bedding, towels, canned food, medicine, soap, school supplies, books, religious articles, and treatments he can collect.

Bishop Moreau made this announcement at the Rectory of Holy Help of Christians here as he was about the subject and need in the 100 villages and cities of his Bengal diocese, visited by him in 1943 and chronically suffering from poverty and pestilence. The Bishop said that if the people of our country (he is a native of Texas) could only see the conditions prevailing in Bengal, at many of our homes they would, their hands would overflow with generosity.

Children to Form 'Living Rosary' at St. Patrick's

The Living Rosary will be enacted at St. Patrick's Church, Elmira, Sunday evening at 7:30 p. m., closing the Month of the Rosary with our Lady's cherished devotion. It is announced at St. Patrick's.

The Cross bearer leads in the procession. After the Cross, a boy representing the Our Father, the three little girls answering the three Hail Marys. Then comes another boy bearing a card naming the first Glorious Mystery. He is followed by ten girls who act as Hail Marys of the first decade. The other four mysteries are symbolized in the same way.

When all have gathered before the Altar, the Rosary is recited, each child answering 10 Hail Marys. After the Our Father and Hail Mary, the boys form a cross and the Hail Mary girls surround it. At the Hail Mary, the girls advance and with the last decade recite an Act of Consecration to Our Blessed Mother.

The Rosary is followed by Hymns and Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament, sung by St. Patrick's Choir Boys.

Each October the Living Rosary is recited in conjunction with the Miraculous Medal Devotion.
